Quarterback Star

Shaughnessy is coaching the Indians through a brilliant season but the man who does their thinking on the field as well as their most spectacular playing is Quarterback Frankie Albert.

Because of the deadly passing Albert is being mentioned in the same breath with the great Sammy Baugh. And his admirers believe that if he doesn't rate all-America at the end of this triumphant Stanford year, next season—he has another year of competition—he is sure to make the grade.

Albert is a left-handed passer and a left-foot kicker. When he's in the game—which is practically all of the time—he does Stanford's punting and goal kicking in addition to calling the plays and handling the ball from centre in Shaughnessy's T formation.

At the end of 1939, Stanford had C. E. "Tiny" Thornhill as football coach for seven years. With his famous "yowing sophomores" he had won a conference championship and a Rose Bowl date three times, but recently things were going badly. Except for his final victory over Dartmouth, the Stanford team was unable to win a single game on the 1939 schedule.

Thornhill was dismissed. About this time the University of Chicago, after a humiliating season of lopsided losses, decided to discontinue football and Shaughnessy became a coach without a team. Stanford hired him.

Shaughnessy, 48, has been identified with football as either player or coach for 30 years. His reputation was made largely at Tulane and Loyola universities in New Orleans.

Shaughnessy brought with him the T formation which the professional Chicago Bears use for offense, and which had been employed only sparingly in east football.
