#### SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Office or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 50 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$20.00 per acre.

Duties—Must reside upon the home stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption, may enter for a purchase on one acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.

**TREASURER HAGEMAN SCORES**

MINEOLA, L. I., Feb. 15.—County Treasurer Daniel J. Hageman scored this morning when he received an opinion from Attorney General Thomas J. Carmody, sustaining his contention in the matter of the sale of the property of the delinquent taxpayers.

Some time ago the treasurer was requested by the Board of Supervisors to advertise the property for unpaid taxes, but he refused until the forms for the advertising were made out as he desired. Under the form recommended by the Nassau official large sums of money were saved to the taxpayers of the county. On one single tract of land in the town of Oyster Bay there was a saving of approximately \$8,000.

The treasurer took the matter up with the State Comptroller, and he was advised by the State official to

advertise the property, according to the forms that had been used in the past. The treasurer refused to comply with the ruling of the State Comptroller, and the matter was finally sent to the Attorney General for his decision.

In the meantime, notwithstanding the resolution of the Board of Supervisors, the treasurer refused to advertise the property. Under the decision of the Attorney General the property of the delinquent taxpayers will be sold under the form advocated by the treasurer, the County of Nassau will be saved approximately \$25,000.
