STRAIGHT FIGHT IN LONDON ELECTION

LONDON, Aug. 16.—Picking the winner in the South Hackney bye-election, where polling takes place on Friday, to fill the vacancy caused by the expulsion of Horatio Bottomley from the House of Commons, is generally regarded as decidedly difficult. The battle is between a Labor candidate, Holford Knight, and a Coalitionist, Captain E. Erskine Hoist.

The Labor candidate has issued a address to the electorate giving expression to extreme views, but ex-service men, who are a big factor in his section of London, are considered to be out of sympathy with the extreme Labor policy. The Coalitionist candidate is himself an ex-soldier.

The Labor canvassers are very diligent and have turned practically every street corner in the constituency into a political platform. On Saturday women voters, who are the most uncertain element of all in elections anywhere in England and nowadays, were harangued as they went about their week-day marketing.

In the last election Bottomley, running as an Independent, polled 11,145 votes against 2,830 given to the Coalition Liberal candidate.

FARMING OF WORLD UNDER ITS SWAY

LONDON, Aug. 16.—The Hague International Court of Justice, by a majority, has decided affirmatively the question submitted by France rising out of the long controversy at the international labor conference at Geneva last October as to whether the international labor organization of the League of Nations was competent to regulate internationally, the hours and other conditions affecting agricultural workers. The French and Roumanian judges dissented. The Hague court decided that the labor organization was not competent to scrutinize the means of production.

INDIA'S WHEAT CROP FAR EXCEEDS THAT OF LAST YEAR

LONDON, Aug. 16.—A Reuter despatch from Calcutta says the final estimate of the 1921-22 Indian wheat crop shows that 28,340,000 acres were under crop, compared with 25,783,000 acres last year. The yield already harvested totals 9,813,000 tons, compared with 6,706,000 tons last year.

The new members chosen without opposition and declared by the returning officer officially elected are: William Kenneth Currie, miner and returned soldier, for Dawson district; Robert White Horse, contractor, for White Horse district; and Emmett Perry, miner and merchant, for Klondike district, which includes the Mayo silver fields and the Klondike gold fields. SHIPPERS AND TRIMMERS AT THE CAPE BRETON PIERS QUIT WORK WITH COAL MINERS AT TWELVE O'CLOCK LAST NIGHT

TEXT OF PROPOSAL MADE BY BRITISH

LONDON, Aug. 16.—The text of Premier Lloyd George's proposal to the Allied Conference on German reparations reads: "Subject to acceptance by the German Government of these guarantees it will be for the Reparation Commission to grant a moratorium in respect to all payments remaining due from Germany up to the 31st of December, 1922 and further the Commission shall, as soon as possible fix the annual payments in cash in respect to all peace treaty charges for the succeeding period as such an amount not exceeding 26 per cent. of the value of German exports, as they may find to be proper with a view to the early flotation of a loan by the German Government, the major portion of which shall be devoted to the payment of reparations."

SASTRI ARRIVES IN CANADA TO PEAD CAUSE OF HINDUS

VICTORIA, B. C., Aug. 16.—To plead the cause of a united India and that his countrymen now resident in Canada are accorded fair treatment, Rt. Hon. Srinivasa Sastri, acknowledged leader of moderation and the anti-Gandhi movement in India, arrived here today aboard the Makura. He probably will remain here a week to confer with Lieut. Governor Nichol and Premier Oliver before starting his tour of Canada. In Ottawa he will discuss the question of Hindu privileges in this country, and will then go to the United States, where he will appear as a private citizen of India to combat anti-British propaganda. The official part of his mission is to work for the parliamentary and municipal franchise for Hindus who are domiciled in Canada under the terms of the Imperial Conference agreement of 1908.

EARTHQUAKE IS REGISTERED ABOUT 5,600 MILES AWAY

WASHINGTON, Aug. 16.—An earthquake of considerable intensity was recorded last night on the seismograph instruments at Georgetown University. The shocks began at 7:32 p. m. and continued for 48 minutes. It was estimated that the disturbance was centred about 5,600 miles from Washington.

Baltic Rum-Running Shows Large Profits

STOCKHOLM, Aug. 16.—Legislation in Sweden against drunkenness and consequent heavy taxation on liquor and beer has resulted in very high prices for alcohol of every kind. So much so that smuggling of drink into Sweden has developed all along the coast, and it is asserted that about 5,000 gallons from the Baltic are landed and sold in Sweden every day.

Recently a German ship was said to be anchored outside territorial waters with a cargo of spirits for sale. In order to establish the truth of this alleged rum-running, the correspondent of The Associated Press decided upon a personal investigation. With a friend he embarked on a six-ton cutter for this German boat, which was expected off Sandhamn and after a pleasant sail in the moonlight came up with the vessel which was riding at anchor with the usual lights showing.

On hulling the vessel we were requested to go aboard and were received cordially by the Captain. "Just waiting for somebody else," he said, "but you are very welcome anyhow." Asked down to the cabin, the visitors explained they were neither buyers of alcohol nor in the service of the customs, but only wanted to learn something first hand about selling spirits on the high seas.

The captain was a young German, about 30 years old. "You take me for a smuggler," he said, "or bootlegger out for business beyond the law, but you are quite mistaken. My name is Ludwig Wolff, formerly of the German navy. I do no business which cannot bear examination, and would not for anything in the world infringe on the privileges of Sweden. I am in international waters and am entitled to trade here as much as I wish with anybody who wants to do business with me. I can offer you the purest and best whiskies, English and American at about 125 a quart. I have the best Danish schnapps for 3 krona a bottle, and many thousand bottles of German brandy."

Wolff, referring to himself, explained that he had been paid off from the navy when the armistice was declared, and on hearing of the liquor trade with Norway, he decided to join in. "I am not dealing for my own account," he said, "this business is organized in Hamburg by big capitalists.
