LEGISLATURE FURTHER POSTPONED.

ST. JOHN, April 6.—Governor MacGregor has issued a proclamation further postponing the re-opening of the Legislature until Saturday. The Governor's action was prompted by a desire to give the Government Leader and the Bondites further time to consider the project of forming a coalition Cabinet in order to save the colony the expense of another general election. The business interests of St. John's are urging both sides to end the deadlock and make some arrangements whereby the affairs of the Island can be administered without embroiling the electorate in a bitter campaign.
