A. By Law for levying and specifying the rate of assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property and Poll in the City of Charlottetown for a Water and Sewerage fund under Statute 1, Edward VII Chapter 2.

The rate of assessment on Real Estate for a Water and Sewerage fund under said Statute for the year commencing the first day of January A. D. 1906 and ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906 is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of one per cent on every dollar of the value of Real Estate as assessed by the Assessors of the said City of Charlottetown in the general assessment Book and Valuation Roll of all Real Estate and Personal Property, liable to taxation in said City and all persons liable to pay Poll Tax therein made and duly returned by them on the 16th day of May A. D. 1906.

The rate of assessment on Personal Property for such Water and Sewerage Fund for the year commencing the first day of January A. D. 1906 and ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906 is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of one quarter of one per cent on every dollar of the value of Personal Property as assessed by the assessors of the said City in said general assessment Book and Valuation Roll made and duly returned by them as aforesaid.

The amount of Poll tax to be paid by every person returned by the said assessors in the said General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll as liable thereto for such water fund under said Statute for the year commencing the first day of January A. D. 1906 and ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906 is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of twenty five cents on every poll of every person so assessed and returned as aforesaid.

A. By Law for levying and specifying the rate of assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for general civic purposes under Statute 3 Edward VII Chapter 17. It is enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:

1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general civic purposes under said Statute for the year commencing the first day of January A. D. 1906 and ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906 is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of one and one eighth per cent on every dollar of the value of Real Estate as assessed by the assessors of the said City of Charlottetown in the General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll of all Real Estate and Personal Property liable to taxation in said City and all persons liable to pay Poll Tax therein made and duly returned by them on the 16th day of May A. D. 1906.

2nd. The rate of assessment on Personal Property for such general civic purposes for the year commencing the first day of January A. D. 1906 and ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906 is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of one and one eighth per cent on every dollar of the value of Personal Property as assessed by the assessors of the said City in the said General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll made and duly returned by them as aforesaid.

A. By Law for allowing the rate of Discount on the assessments on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for general civic purposes for the current year ending the thirty first day of December A. D. 1906.

It is enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows: 1st. A discount at the rate of two and one half per cent shall be allowed to all Tax payers who shall, on or before the twentieth day of July A. D. 1906 pay the City Clerk at his office the taxes severally due by them for the current year on Real Estate and Personal Property for civic purposes.

EXTENDING THE BUILDINGS FOR THE DOMINION EXHIBITION

The Entries for the Exhibition Stake Races Close on June 15th.

Great improvements necessary by the enhanced demands of the Dominion Exhibition, are being made on the Grounds at Halifax. The Fisheries Building, a splendid up-to-date structure, has this season been added to the departmental edifices. All the other buildings will be greatly extended, and the capacity of the Grand Stand will be doubled, making it capable of accommodating 8,000 persons.

The floor space of the different departmental buildings for the big Fair will total 188,000 square feet. Steps have been taken as once to expropriate an acre of additional land adjoining the Exhibition grounds, thus affording an opportunity to erect a new main entrance and commodious office building.

Included in the Race Program for the great meeting to be held during nine days on the Exhibition track, will be six Stake Races, entries for which close on June 15th, at which date \$5.00 or 1% of the entrance fee will be payable. The aggregate of purses for the races is \$20,000, giving \$1,000 daily in Prize money. The Exhibition Track has this season been graded, according to the original plans, topped over with sifted earth, and made what is believed to be the fastest in the Maritime Provinces.

The Dominion Exhibition will run for two weeks, September 22nd to October 5th, and its premiums will amount to \$100,000.
