KIMBALL, Neb., Mar. 4.—R. B. Franklin, justice of the peace of this town, holds that milking the cows and feeding the cattle is no part of a woman's domestic duties.

Benjamin R. Bolton and Mary C. Prentice were married three years ago and came to Banner county to reside, settling on a homestead a few miles from Kimball.

There was record in the family and the wife went before Justice Franklin, who issued a warrant. At the hearing Bolton was put under bonds to keep the peace.

The court held that under the circumstances the kisses were valueless and that the wife was not bound to receive them, they not being in good faith.

RICH WIDOW CHEF'S BRIDE.

KANSAS CITY, Mo., March 6.—It was the intention of Frank P. Smith, once chef at the Midland Hotel, but now a millionaire banker and land owner, and Mrs. Ordelia R. Flark, widow of Henry D. Clark, a Kansas City capitalist and theatrical man, when they were married at midnight just a week ago tonight, to keep the wedding a secret.

"We did not intend to announce our marriage," Mrs. Smith said today, "until just before we were ready to leave town. Mr. Smith has just inherited \$3,000,000 from a New York uncle and he thought best that the wedding should be kept secret on that account."

"There was no one present except my children and a few close friends. They were all sworn to secrecy for business reasons and I don't know how it got out."

Smith is a nephew of Mrs. Charles Fair, who with her husband was killed in an auto accident several years ago.
