TORONTO MAN FOUND DEAD.

HAMILTON, Feb. 13—Fred. Reid was found dead in bed at the Dominion Hotel here at noon today. He was assistant superintendent of the National Mercantile Agency, Toronto.

KELLEY TAKEN TO PRISON

PORTLAND, Me., Feb. 13—Wm. J. Kelly, of Richmond, Carleton County (N. B.), sentenced to fourteen years in prison for assault on U. S. customs official, was taken to the federal prison at Atlanta, (Ga.) today.

GOOD STORY UNTRUE

FORT FAIRFIELD, Me., Feb. 13—Hundreds of people thronged Andover (N. B.), tonight, one mile from the boundary line and three miles from Fort Fairfield village, to see a blazing meteorite which hurtled down from the skies and buried itself with an earth-shaking crash in the ground, about 8 o'clock this evening. The meteorite, which weighs many tons and is 15 or 20 feet in diameter, is still so hot that it is impossible to approach nearer than within 100 yds of it. The glowing mass resembles burning saltpetre.

Many of the people in this section of the state saw this spectacular descent from the southeastern sky. Some of the spectators believed that it was a portion of Halley's comet visiting the earth ahead of time, they said. (Just after this despatch had been placed in type there came another saying it was without foundation.)

HALIFAX THE HEADQUARTERS.

OTTAWA, Feb. 14—Halifax will be the headquarters of the Atlantic squadron of the Canadian navy. A naval college, to be built at the cost of \$150,000, will be located there together with naval barracks and admiralty dock-yards. Halifax will also be the base of three cruisers and six destroyers constituting the Atlantic squadron. These vessels will have 1,449 men and eighty-seven officers, and the total annual expenditure for the maintenance of the naval college, dock-yards, barracks, vessels and men on the Atlantic coast is estimated at \$2,402,000.

DR. COOK LOCATED.

VALDIVIA, Chili, Feb. 14—Dr. Cook and his wife have arrived here on board the German steamer Osiris, having taken a cabin at Montivideo. Dr. Cook travelled under the name of Craig. He and his wife sailed north and declined to be interviewed.

\$50,000,000 SUGAR REFINERY COMPANY INCORPORATED.

OTTAWA, Feb. 13—The Atlantic Sugar Refining Company has been incorporated by letters patent, with a capital of \$5,000,000 and head office in Montreal. The incorporators are a Montreal legal firm, evidently representing the financial interests behind the enterprise. Power is given to refine and deal in sugar.

EXONERATES CAPT. RENNIE FOR STRANDING CORINTHIAN.

HALIFAX, Feb. 13—The wreck commissioners, Captains Lugar, Hall and Cole, today gave a decision in the stranding of the steamer Corinthian on George's Island in December last. The decision in part states: "The stranding was caused by an error of judgment on the part of the master in estimating his distance from a schooner showing no lights, and also from the shoal on the northwest point of George's Island. A correct judgment of distance was probably prevented by the strong glare from the electric lights on the wharves.

"We are of the opinion the master, Captain Alex. Rennie, was fully justified in manoeuvring the Corinthian in the manner and therefore should be exonerated from all blame for the stranding of the vessel."

ONTARIO COLLECTOR OF CUSTOMS FOUND DEAD.

ST. THOMAS, Ont., Feb. 13—Granville Haight, customs collector at Aylmer, was found dead in bed this morning from heart failure. Deceased was about fifty-eight years of age, and leaves his wife, son and daughter, mother and two sisters.

FRENCH FISHERMEN RIOT.

GRAVELINES, France, Feb. 13—Striking Grand Bank fishermen today attacked a detachment of gendarmes, injuring two of them. Afterwards they stopped the officers of ship owners. Finally, however, order was restored.
