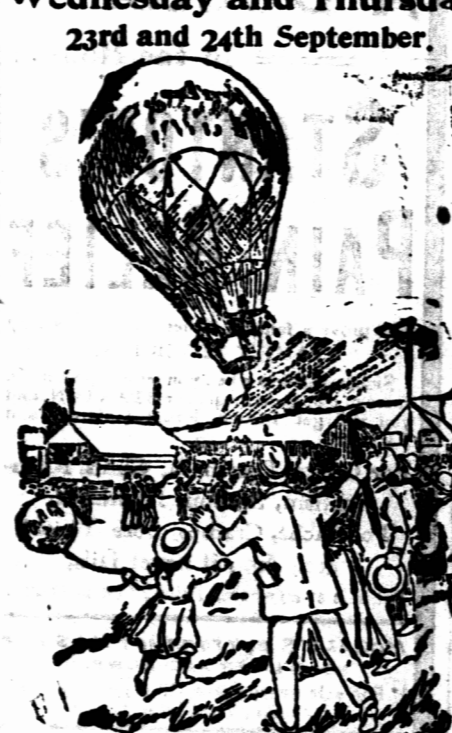

COL. HARRINGTON.

Only Common Soldier Who Rose From the Ranks to British Minister.

Colonel John Harrington, who has just presented to the Emperor of Abyssinia, to whose court he is accredited as Minister resident, a superb and perfectly trained Indian elephant, as a token of friendship from King Edward, is the only chief de mission in the diplomatic service of Great Britain who has risen to that office from the position of a common soldier in the ranks. In 1888 the Colonel, who received the Order of the Bath some years ago, and is now about to become Sir John as a Knight Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St. George, was a private in the Middlesex regiment of infantry. A year later he won a commission, and eighteen months afterwards was transferred to that picked body, the Indian Staff Corps. Before long he volunteered for service as Vice-Consul at Zoolah, a pestilential place, which serves as one of the seaports to Abyssinia, the post on question being avoided as much as possible by the other members of the corps, by reason of its loneliness and unhealthiness. So good was the use which Harrington made of his opportunities that he was able to render invaluable assistance to the special mission of Sir Rennell Rodd to Emperor Menelik in 1897, striking up a great friendship with Lord Edward Cecil, the soldier son of Lord Salisbury, who formed part of Sir Rennell's staff. The result was that when the British Government resolved upon establishing a permanent Legation in Abyssinia, where British interests are exceedingly important, both Sir Rennell and Lord Edward Cecil warmly recommended Lieutenant Harrington for the post. He has since received military promotion, and the influence which he has been able to acquire over the dusky potentate to whom he is accredited is so great that it has completely relegated into the background that of Russia and of France, which formerly predominated at Adis Abeba.

How He Settled Theft Charge.
