Prince Edward Island has been called by many flattering names "The Denmark of Canada," "The Garden of the Gulf," "Canada's Agricultural Gem", "The Kentucky of Canada," names that associate in ones mind at once some phase of agricultural development.

Our brainy stock men have gone far afield and won honors in the show ring at the Royal Winter Fair, the Amherst Winter Fair and many other notable fairs. They have bred the finest in dairy and other cattle breeds, the best in draft and harness horses, poultry, sheep and swine.

From Monday evening August 19th to the 23rd the choicest specimens that this Province affords will be on view here. Every citizen should be interested in seeing them.

HORSES

Prizes for standard bred, carriage, roadsters, saddle horses, ponies, Clydesdale, Percheron, Draft and General Purpose horses. Special boys colt classes.

CATTLE

Enlarged prizes for beef breeds, Shorthorns, Dual Purpose Shorthorns, Dairy breeds such as Ayrshires, Holstein-Fresian, Guernseys and Jerseys

SHEEP

Increased prizes for Shropshire Downs, South Downs, Oxford Downs, Champion Ram, Grades and Market Class.

SWINE

Increased prizes in 11 sections for Yorkshires, special prizes for bacon class, pen of five bacon hogs and Champion bacon hog.

POULTRY

Enlarged prizes for fowls, Cornish, Bantam, Leghorn, Minorca, Orpington, Plymouth Rock, Rhode Island Red, Wyandotte. CHICKENS, 25 classes for chickens. Prizes for production class, breeding pen adults, young breeding pens, etc., etc. Prizes for turkeys, geese, ducks and dressed poultry and for brown, white and commercial eggs.

DAIRY PRODUCTS

Dairy products form a most important part of Prince Edward Island's shipments abroad. They are well taken care of in our prize list. There are prizes for creamery butter, dairy butter and exhibition factory cheese.

AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Prizes for grains and seeds such as wheat, barley, black oats, banner oats, white oats, buckwheat, peas, beans, timothy and flaxseed.

INDUSTRIAL PRIZES

For fancy work, embroidery, crochet, hooked mats, miscellaneous, art work, oil paintings, water colours, pastels, commercial art, china painting, professional painting, prizes for young and old from seven to seventy.

FIELD ROOTS AND VEGETABLES

61 sections with prizes for carrots, mangles, potatoes, turnips, cabbage, cauliflower, celery, corn, cucumbers, melons, onions, parsnips, pumpkins, squash, tomatoes and special farm product prizes for best exhibits of varieties. Fruit prizes for large and small fruits, plant and flower prizes for flowers in pots, cut flowers, comprising 62 sections.

MISCELLANEOUS

Prizes for amateur photography, professional photography, honey and apiary supplies, domestic science, for exhibits of bread, cake, preserve and jellies, canned fruits, vegetables, meats and pickles.

FISHERIES DEPARTMENT

Prizes for best boneless codfish, kippered herring, mackerel and canned lobsters.

For the public schools, prizes for educational and natural history, manual training, collections of birds, insects, weeds, etc.

MANUFACTURING AND INDUSTRIAL

Prizes for sets of driving harness, collections of tinware, soaps (toilet and laundry,) apple boxes, cheese boxes, butter tubs, collections of baskets, flower stands, Indian moccasins, book binding, sheepskin mats, home made radio sets and hundreds of other prizes for various articles domestic and agricultural, impossible to list here.
