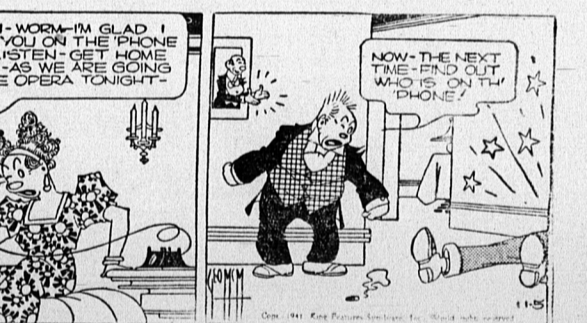
Army battles Notre Dame Scoreless draw
