**OUR FRIENDS AND OUR WORK**  
The Address Delivered by Rev. G. R. White at the Recent Sunday-School Convention in the Methodist Brick Church in This City.

Fe low-workers: I have been much perplexed as to what I should say on this occasion. When a subject is assigned me I feel that someone else has to share with me the responsibility. But for safety I have given myself plenty of sea-room as you will see when I tell you that I have taken as a subject: **Our Friends and Our Work.** Our friends and our work are two of the great factors in our daily life. Their removal would make a great breach in our wall, for their presence fills our hearts with their presence and pleasure. We are most thankful for our friends in connection with this convention. We have them at home and from abroad. And we esteem them highly, not only for their work's sake, but also for their work's sake. The work of our convention has found many friends in the past, who were not directly connected with any of our Sunday Schools, but who are deeply interested in the welfare of the young, and who look to the Sunday School as one of the strongest agencies in the welfare of the boys and girls. To our friends from abroad, let me say, that we welcome you both old and new in a truly genuine fashion, to our Province, to our convention, and we most earnestly hope that you will feel much at home among us. Let me say that we remember with pleasure and profit such names as Marion Lawrence, whose genial Christian spirit and well-attested mind in Sunday school has poured upon us much of the wealth of his experience in the working of the Sunday school. Mrs. Bryner too has left her mark upon this convention, and upon each individual who had the good fortune to hear her. And Prof. Excell is highly esteemed and who brought with him the grace and charm that soothes even the savage beast. And we have again our esteemed Mr. W. C. Pearce who has spoken many helpful and inspiring words, as well as giving us much good counsel in the conduct of affairs. We are glad to see Mr. Pearce. He can say: "Ye are glad and peaks in with you once again" may heaven continue to smile upon your path, brother. And we give a special

welcome to our new friends who are here for the first time—Mr. G. C. Tuller and Mr. H. Marsullo and Mr. Keener who also came to represent the glory and harmony of song at our Convention. I hope we have not impressed you unfavorably, brethren, we are glad to have you. Perhaps I should say in this connection, that we welcome also our new secretary—Rev. Mr. Ganong, Mr. Ganong, so far as we have heard, has done good and helpful work among our districts during the summer months, and has kept well in touch with our work. Considering the wide field he has to cover, I may say to our friends from abroad, that we have great faith and large hope in this Canada of ours, while at the same time we have the most kindly feelings and large hope concerning your great nation. We believe that we have here in Canada the resources of a great and triumphant nation. Therefore we have no sympathy with the word "annexation." And I may say to our American friends, that we have quite decided not to annex the United States, and we have more than decided that the United States will never annex Canada. But we do rejoice in the warm friendly national feeling that exists between the two greatest flags on God's footstool—the Union Jack and the Stars and Stripes. It may be that these two great flags will yet be blended into one, to take the world for Jesus Christ, which is the will and the purpose of God, we will rejoice and be glad.  
Our work: It is a great work. It is great in extent of area. From its humble origin under Raikes it has moved forward in ever widening circles until today it touches all lands on all civilized and Christianized shores. And today Sunday school work stands forth as the most potent factor for good among the young in all the world. This work is great because God is so manifest in it. The Sunday School is today the greatest religious teaching agency on the earth. It is shaping the youthful mind in truth and holiness to a marvelous degree. What a spiritual loss would the direct and indirect influence of the Sunday School be to the church and the world. The power and influence of a work may be judged to some extent by the number and character of its followers. In this regard the Sunday School is in the front ranks. Millions are today under its benign influence, and some of earth's brightest spirits have given their lives to this work. And the Sunday School today numbers in her ranks some of God's finest characters. Ah, this is indeed a great work, viewed from whatever standpoint you choose. Let its greatness inspire us to do still greater things for God and the rising generation.  
"Life is not an idle word."  
But iron, dug from central gloom, And heated hot with burning tears, And dived in baths of hissing tears, And battered with the stroke of doom, To shape and use.  
It is a glorious work. In Sunday School work we seek first and last the glory of God. That clothes the work with sacredness as with a garment, and spreads such a halo of light about it, as to sanctify, inspire, and influence every worker within the charmed circle. For God standeth within that circle "keeping watch above His own." The reflex influence of such a work is also great. We have much said on the debt of the child to the parent, and it is great. But the parent owes much to the child. Theodore Parker said: "A baby in the home is better than a whole academy of philosophers." That I presume is because philosophers talk so much that is not real, while all that the baby does or says is both genuine and real. There is none of the speculative about the baby. The cry at 2 a. m. is a real shout in the camp. My point is this, brethren, that this Sunday School work has done more for us than we have done for it. The home owes much to the little ones. The importance then of bending energy of body and soul to the carrying forward of Sunday School work is apparent to all. Now, who or what is the most important factor in the work of the Sunday School? The President of the Convention? No. The Field Secretary? No. The International Convention? No. The Superintendent in the local school? No. The local Teacher? Yes. The teacher is the most important

**BANK OF ENGLAND DISCOUNT RATE**

New York, Oct. 25—The action of the governors of the Bank of England in raising the discount rate to 6 per cent., the highest figure since 1890, or the 6 per cent., early in the Boer War period, and before that only equalled in recent times when 6 per cent. was the rate in the Barren panic of 1890, has drawn attention sharply to the troubled condition of the foreign markets. The raising of the German bank rate to the unusually high figure of 8 per cent. might have been passed over as an incident of the quarter-end money flowing in Berlin, but the immediate following up of this action in London is a plain enough indication of the unusual conditions prevailing on the foreign markets. While money conditions here have been improving rapidly, exactly the reverse has been the case on the other side of the ocean.
