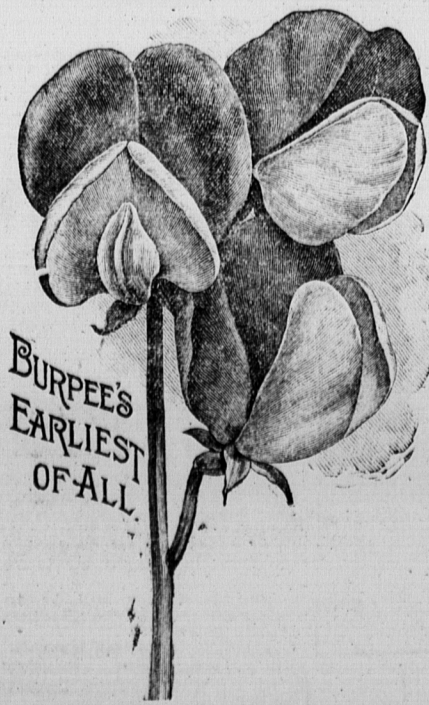

LEPROSY SUSPECT ELUDES HIS GUARD.

NORTH ADAMS, May 25—John Anthony, the youth who was detained in quarantine as a leprosy suspect, escaped during the night, and the police have been unable to find any trace of him. It is believed that Anthony is making his way through Vermont to Canada, and it is also thought that he will seek to return to his former home in Syria, sailing from some Canadian port.

He had been under observation since last Thursday. A physician who has made a special study of leprosy said that Anthony was suffering from the disease, and arrangements were made to remove him today to Penikese Island, in Buzzard's Bay, Massachusetts' leper colony.

The building where Anthony was confined was a six-tenement structure on Lower State Street in the section of North Adams known as Little Syria. Only one policeman was detailed by the board of health to guard both front and rear entrances to the house. This forenoon it was discovered by the officer on duty that Anthony was missing, and investigation showed that the man left the building at 9.45 p. m. yesterday.

All points from which Anthony would be liable to sail on his return to his native country have been notified to detain the man.

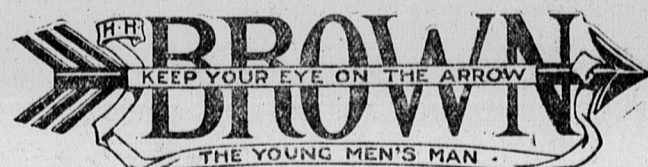
