THE schooner Restive owned by Joseph Reid & Co., and one of the most familiar of our harbor craft is no more; the following despatch telling of her wreck was received here by the owner yesterday.

Pabos Mills, Que., Oct. 18, Joseph Reid & Co.

Restive total wreck. Saved our lives and just all ashore at Pabos. Will save all we can. Wire instructions or better come yourself.

The Restive left here about ten days ago with a cargo of hay and oats and with sixteen horses on deck. The horses were for jasper and were landed at that port. The oats and hay were for Pabos. In a letter from the captain dated Oct. 14 he stated that on account of rough weather he had to lay at anchor at Port Daniel for three days. The above telegram was the next word to arrive. Whether they hay and oats had been landed is not known here. The schooner was expected to return with a cargo of lumber. The Restive was built at Bonomey, N. S., in 1884 and was 74 tons register. She has been owned by Joseph Reid & Co., for about 15 years. There was no insurance on the vessel.


