## Plans Completed For Viscount Montgomery's Visit

### Warrants Out For Textile Union Officers

QUEBEC, Aug. 23—(CP)—Premier Maurice Duplessis announced at a press conference today that warrants have been issued for the arrest of Kent Bowley, Canadian director of the United Textile Workers of America (A.F.L.) and Aseluis Besse, Valleyfield organizer of the union.

The Premier did not list the exact charges against the textile union officials but said they came under the headings of sedition, illegal assembly, conspiracy, damage to property, obstructing provincial police in the performance of their duty, and rioting.

Three warrants had been issued, the Premier said, with a maximum sentence of seven years possible for conviction on charges contained in the first, and two years in the other two.

The Premier said no action had been taken yet in connection with Madeleine Parent, union organizer.

### Halifax Flag-Draped For Montgomery Visit

HALIFAX, Aug. 23—(CP)—Premiers in general were shyness poles here tonight unwinding miles of bunting and pennants as this old garrison city decked itself gaily to welcome Field Marshal Viscount Montgomery arriving here tomorrow morning.

Ships of the Atlantic squadron were stripped of their dressiest signals to furnish the endless line of decorations which are inter-front contributions that feature welcomes like "Good Old Monty."

A corps of bay army officers, responsible for the planning of the 17-day tour which will take the hero of El Alamein to Victoria and back, tonight pointedly referred to reports that the rather eccentric soldier ruled out certain social activities and formalities. They declared that as a matter of fact the Chief of the Imperial General Staff had not been consulted on details and was not responsible for such decisions as a bar against women being present at some gatherings and the omission of an artillery salute.

Most of the details which will deal with the Field Marshal's visit, they said, and he had exercised no veto power on anything. "As a matter of fact the 'old man' had lent himself diligently to the big program that lies before him," said an officer, who was formerly with Montgomery in the field.

### POLISH GOLD TO BE HELD BY BRITAIN

LONDON, Aug. 23—(CP)—A Polish accusation of "open interference" by Britain in Poland's internal affairs brought a reply today that Britain would continue to hold \$16,000,000 in Polish gold until the Poles fulfill assurances of "free general elections."

A Polish spokesman Tuesday noted to Poland criticizing the conduct of the June national referendum and asking Britain to democratic and anti-Nazi parties be allowed free participation in the November Polish elections. The United States sent a similar note.

A Polish Embassy spokesman today rejected Britain's allegations that voting in the referendum was not free and charged Britain was "taking sides" by giving diplomatic support to opposite parties. He said the British government's statement of elections was being fulfilled.

A Polish Foreign Office spokesman immediately declared there was nothing in the Polish statement to indicate that the Potsdam declaration for free and democratic elections was being fulfilled.

The Polish spokesman said, "The Polish government will not receive the \$6,000,000 in Polish gold held in London, nor certain demobilization funds and other benefits arranged under an Anglo-Polish financial accord signed here in 1945, until the Poles fulfill their obligations."

### "Monty" Foot-Sloggers' Champions

Field Marshal Montgomery, who arrives at Halifax today and will visit Charlottetown on Monday, has no hobbies—unless you regard the British Army as his pastime. Its improvement and the welfare of the ordinary soldier are his continual concern.

You can define genius in many ways, and easily find a number of public figures to illustrate the definition. Of the man who so successfully commanded the Eighth Army in North Africa and Sicily, and who was given command of the Allied Forces in France, the difficulty is to select the one which most closely coincides with his real personality.

You must make your choice before the "Monty" who so inspired the British troops that their admiration became hero-worship, and the Field-Marshal who started and even worried other military leaders by his own worship of the unorthodox.

Monty has been likened in turn to a modern Cromwell and a "Military Churchill." His critics, on the other hand, have dubbed him "The Army's Showman No. 1."

Never before did Britain have a military leader so intent upon appealing directly to the rank and file of his troops, or so openly setting out to sell his personality to his soldiers.

That was what Monty did prior to the Allied landing in Normandy. Touring Britain in his special train, he made scores of man-to-man speeches before whole brigades. He talked easily and impromptu to them, though his addresses were actually carefully prepared, rehearsed, and memorized. He came into closer contact with the ordinary soldier than any other general ever commended to us.

One of the tenets of his reasoning is that the present-day trooper is a far better educated man than the soldier of a few decades ago. The soldier of today deserves our confidence, he once declared. "Further, the man who knows exactly what he is fighting for, and how he fits into the general scheme of military strategy, is likely to make the best soldier."

### Concern Is Expressed By Shippers

WOODSTOCK, N.B., Aug. 23—(CP)—Grave concern was reported today among producers and shippers of seed potatoes as a result of decision by the Special Products Board, Ottawa, to discontinue its operations regarding the marketing of certified seed in South America, Central America and the West Indies. Failure of some shippers to cooperate with the Board was given as the reason for the decision.

Directors of the New Brunswick Potato Growers Council have decided to appeal for action to protect the growers' interests. The Council considered it would be necessary for the growers to form their own marketing organization.

### Here Monday With Party Of Thirty

Plans have now been completed in detail for Monday's big event in the history of Prince Edward Island—the visit of Field Marshal the Viscount Montgomery of Alamein, G.C.B., D.S.O., famous commander of British forces in World War II and present Chief of the Imperial General Staff.

The Field Marshal's visit will be brief—little more than three hours from the time of his arrival at the Charlottetown airport at 11:20 a.m. until his departure at 2:40 p.m. for Saint John, N.B. The programme will be confined to a reception at the Provincial Building, a mass meeting with war veterans at Victoria Park, and an official luncheon at Government House; but the public will have ample opportunity of seeing and acclaiming the distinguished guest as he will be driven in an open car through the streets of the city and suburbs.

### PARTY NUMBERS THIRTY

Travelling with the Field Marshal from England is a party of British army officers and other ranks. At Halifax today he will be met by a party of Canadian army and R.C.A.F. officers and other ranks who will continue with him on his Canadian tour. The full party numbers thirty and will include the following: British party: Lieut. Col. G. S. Cole, O.B.E.; Major N. W. Cheverton.

### Increases In Wages Granted To Railwaymen

MONTREAL, Aug. 23—(CP)—Wage increases of 10 cents an hour retroactive to June 1 for members of all but two of the Labor organizations representing employees of the Canadian National Railways and subsidiaries and the Ontario Northland Railway were announced today by railway officials.

The new agreement, reached after several weeks of negotiations, affects some 100,000 workers of the two railways and becomes effective after approval by the National War Labour Board, the announcement was made.

The two exceptions to the agreement are the Brotherhood of Railway Employees and the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen. The former previously received increases of two cents an hour and the latter, which represents approximately seven per cent of the railways' employees, received a 10-cent increase of eight cents. Negotiations are continuing in the case of the latter, which represents approximately seven per cent of the railways' employees.

Comments on the agreement, R.C. Vaughan, C.M.G., chairman and president of Canadian National Railways, said:

"Although the negotiations were prolonged, they were conducted in a characteristic fashion which is characteristic of relations between this company and its employees."
