MINING

TORONTO, Jan. 20 — (CP) — Stocks drifted about aimlessly today on the Toronto market and closed lower on diminishing volume. Turnover was the smallest of the week at \$13,000 shares. Gold shares, up .47 in the index had the only gain while the western oils dropped a full point, the Nickel .56 and the base metals .32. Accumulation of Wright-Harveys at strong prices was about the only bullish note in a generally dark picture. The price went to 8.55 which was top for recent years. Two juniors, Naybob and Augite, also traded in heavy volume. Chesterville bulked in the day's action and it closed 4 cents up at 1.34. Kerr-Addison held about steady. The close was up narrowly for East Mairlie, O'Brien, Oro Plata, Pickle Crow, Sisco, and Teck Hughes and lower for Hard Rock, Little Long Lac, mining Corporation and Sigma. Changes were narrow in the base metal group. Noranda weakened 1-2 and Smelters and Nickel dropped 1-4 point. A sagging tendency ruled the junior oils throughout the session. Home slipped back 19 cents to 2.86. Foothills lost 15 cents and declines of 3 to 5 cents were posted.
