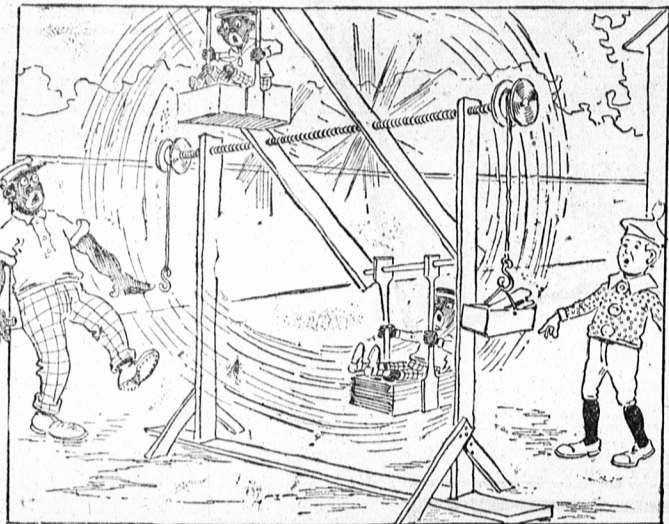
Dear Tommy: Here's a diagram of a Ferris wheel I built for Jim's twins.



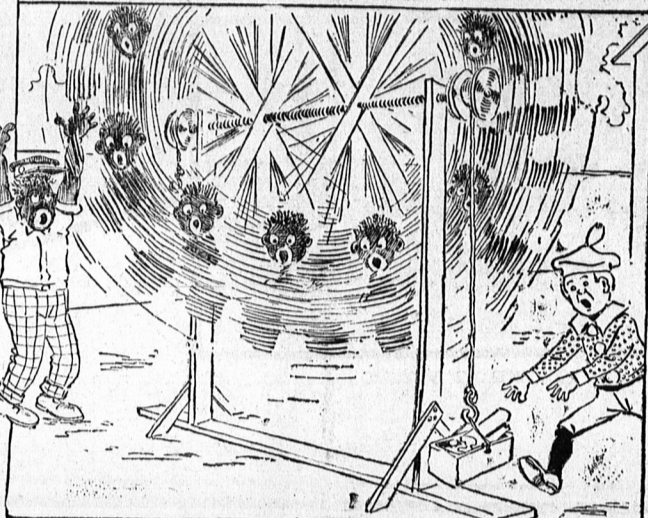
They balance so nicely it didn't take much weight to turn the machine.



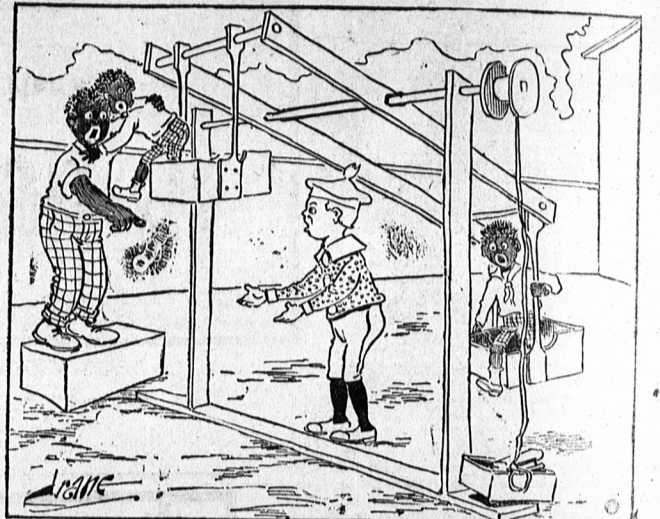
But I tried a little more weight to get on extra speed.

It nearly shook the twins apart before the weight reached the bottom.



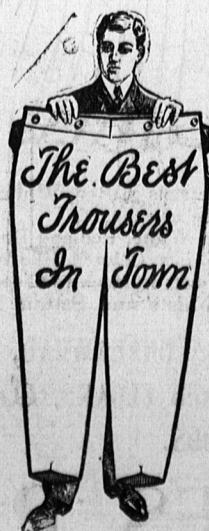
They weren't hurt a bit; but, my! Jim was mad. Yours, Willie.
