**WELCOME VISITOR**—Among the welcome visitors to the Island is Rev. John Pringle of Sydney, who motored here on Saturday evening and who gave a brief address in Trinity United Church Sunday evening mainly reminiscences of his boyhood days in Prince Edward Island. Dr. Pringle, as is well known, was born in Charlottetown, but left here when a child. For eight years he lived in Murray Harbour with his grand-parents, the late Mr and Mrs John Cowan. After leaving there he had a most varied and interesting experience, spending ten years in the Yukon and preaching in various parts of Canada. During the years 1919-1920 he was Moderator of the Presbyterian General Assembly but joined the United Church at the time of the union in 1925. Dr. Pringle has been pastor of St. Andrew's United Church in Sydney since 1908. He is now known as Pastor Emeritus, having no administrative duties but supplying congregations from time to time. The Doctor has frequently lectured in Prince Edward Island on his experiences in the Yukon and has also preached in a number of our churches. On his present visit he is the guest of Mr and Mrs John F. MacDonald, Upper Prince Street. Yesterday he left for Murray Harbour on a visit to the scenes of his boyhood and will remain on the Island for about a week.

### A CANADIAN PLAYGROUND

North of the great fertile belt devoted to agriculture there lies in the province of Saskatchewan, Canada, a region of rocks, woods, and water which seems almost to have been formed by nature as a special playground for man. Here are found thousands of crystal lakes. White birch, jack pine, and white spruce grow here to unusual size and beauty. Pickersel, pike, and gray trout are plentiful in the lakes and streams, while moose, deer, bear and many species of game birds abound. A typical example of this region is Prince Albert national park. It was set aside in 1928 and is an important addition to Canada's already fine system of national reservations.

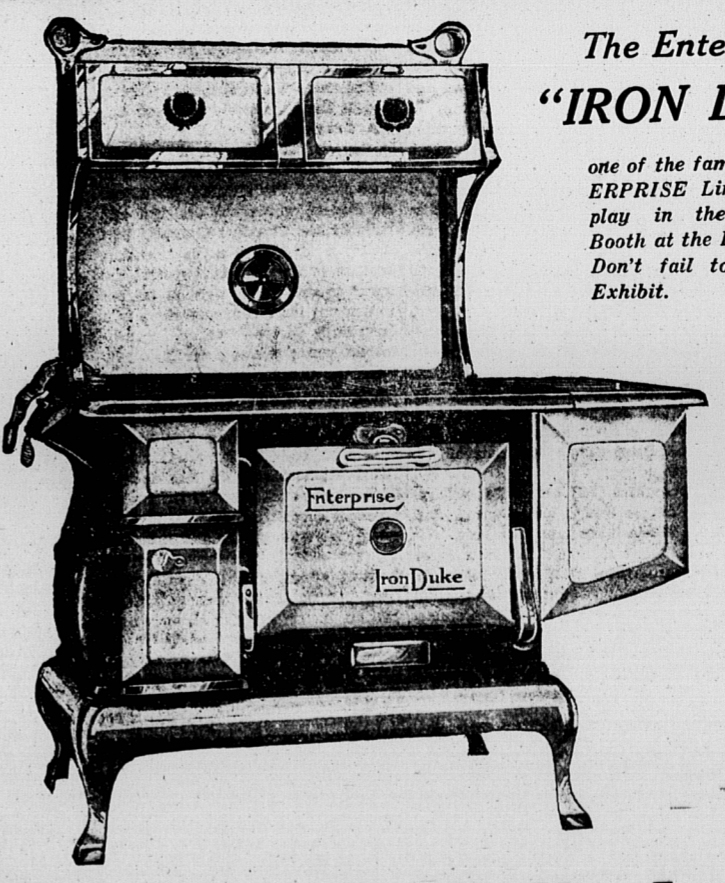
