WARS AND RUMORS OF WARS.

American exchanges tell of an impression prevalent in their country that the Boer war may be indefinitely prolonged because of the new trouble that has arisen in the far East.

Britain has been the head and front of all movements to check Russian aggression, whether in Southern Europe or in Central or Eastern Asia.

Russia is well aware of these conditions. She has already 100,000 men on the Pacific coast. To cope with them, if once Russia became openly hostile, Britain would have her fleets, it is true, but they would not be enough.

The Boers have unfortunately still a large number of British prisoners—how many we do not know, but the recent capture of a Derbyshire battalion has added to their number.

MR. S. E. REID'S SPEECH.

THE GUARDIAN greatly regrets that Mr. S. E. Reid in his speech on the third reading of the Prohibitory Bill as reported in the Patriot, should have thought it necessary to enter upon a defence of the License Law of last year.

Moreover Mr. Reid thought it worth while to set up again the old and exploded notion that the fee paid by the liquor dealers of Charlottetown as a consideration for which they were "authorized to sell" was a "tax" and not a license fee.

We must strongly dissent from those portions of Mr. Reid's speech to which we have referred. In common with the Temperance Alliance, the Grand Division Sons of Temperance, the Grand Lodge of Good Templars and the various religious bodies that have spoken on the subject, we regard the basic principles of license and prohibition as distinctly opposed and irreconcilable.
