AFTERNOON SESSION

The afternoon session opened with a service of worship led by Rev. A. Gibson. "Objectives in Religious Education," was the subject of an interesting and instructive address delivered by Mr. Roy A. Burkhardt. The objectives suggested were decided on by a large number of religious educators in a comprehensive survey of the matter. The greatest objectives in this most important type of education are to help every boy and girl to be fully committed to the Christian way of life, to achieve Jesus' understanding of the universe—we are rapidly interpreting the great natural laws as the laws of God—to help each youth to find the real secret of worship. In regard to the latter objective Mr. Burkhardt said that ten years ago young people were asking whether it was right or wrong to dance or smoke. Five years ago getting was under discussion. Last year the question was "How May I find God?" Another objective is to help young people to find an appreciation for work, personality, music, literature, the home and its place in our social order, and to make every boy and girl an efficient home-maker. The last and perhaps most important objective is to help young people to achieve a Christian purpose in life. In this phase of education the church has the best opportunity. The Christian business man is just as important in the world as the minister, and the modern scientist is just as valuable as the old prophets.

The convention broke up into special conferences for discussion of various phases of the work. A practical study on Home Religion was led by Rev. F. M. Milligan and Miss Hilde Allen; on Missionary Education by Rev. A. Gibson; on Temperance Education by Rev. Manson Doyle; on Church Vocation schools by Miss Annie E.
