Mr. Reid is the proud owner of Sunny-slope Bonnie Jean, having finished her two year old record last February with 9200 lbs. milk, she freshened again the last of April, and at the present time is averaging 60 lbs. a day. Mr. Reid expects her to go over the 5,000 lbs mark in the first three months. She has the advantage of being a persistent milk'er, which will, if nothing unforeseen happens, pave her way for a three year old Maritime record. Mr. Lannan was very fortunate in securing from the McGowen Estate, Lady Heatherbloom of Spruce Row, a large mature cow, good feeder if pushed, capable of yielding 70 lbs. a day. At present she is averaging about 54 lbs. a day, on two milkings. Both those cows are running in the R. O. P., with 4% butter fat tests.
