WINNIPEG, March 23.—Three men, employed in blasting for a new power dam of the Revelstoke Hydro-Electric plant, lost their lives yesterday. The men were working on a platform under an overhanging ledge of rock when a slab, eight feet by twelve, fell from above, crushing them. Six other men, working below, escaped injury.

FIFTEEN MILLION FOR TWO GRUES.

CINCINNATI, March 22.—The two grand-daughters of Alexander McDonald, Standard Oil magnate, who died Friday night at Long Beach, Cal., will come into the possession of his estate of \$15,000,000.

They are Laura, 17, and Helena Stallo, 19, daughters of the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. McDonald, and who died five years ago in New York.

Mr. Stallo later married the divorced wife of Ben Hanna, who was the uncle of Mr. McDonald. He himself took charge of his grand daughters and they were constantly with him, being seated beside his chair when he died suddenly.

The Misses Stallo will bring his body here from California, and will then make their home at "Dalvay," his \$2,000,000 home in Clifton Avenue in Cincinnati. They are his only heirs.

One plan Mr. McDonald had was that each of the young women should choose her own husband, and that nobody should have a word to say regarding their marriages.

Mr. McDonald was a believer in what he called "the good old-fashioned way of marriage," and often said that young people were marrying for themselves, not for anybody else.

DIGBY, N. S., March 22.—Captain John W. Snow has sold his 43 shares of the schooner Wilfred L. Snow, now at Syda & Cousins' wharf to Capt. Herbert Johnson, of Port Wade. The remaining shares are owned by Syda and Cousins and Capt. Phinney, the latter being her last year's skipper.
