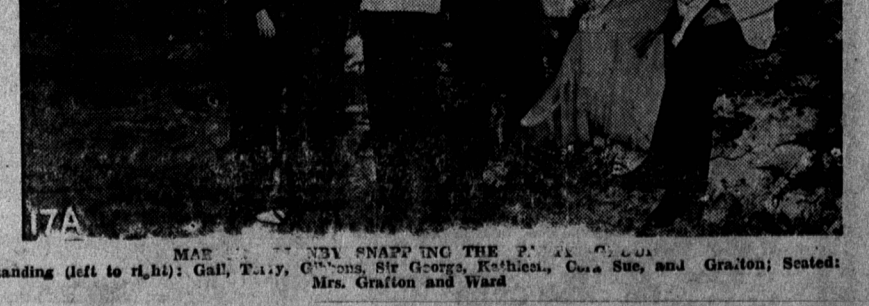
Decide right now, how much weight you want to lose, then plan sensible diet and exercise schedules. Have a shampoo once a week, and brush your hair every night.
