Wheat & Lumber Markets Assured for Canada Now

Premier Bennett's Stand On Soviet Trade Menace Regarded As Signal Victory At Empire Conference

OTTAWA, Aug. 22—(Canadian Press Staff Writer)—Removal of the Soviet Russia "menace" in the markets of official circles as a signal victory for Canada.

"Canada is assured of a world market in wheat by the clause in the agreement covering Soviet Russia, and the six cents per bushel preference."

"Russian marketing methods and slaughtered prices have been the influence more than anything else that has kept Canadian lumber out of the United Kingdom for the past ten years."

Enormous decreases in shipments of Canadian wheat and lumber have been caused by the under selling methods in the United Kingdom under state monopoly and low standards of living.

Canada, on February 26 last, placed an embargo against importation from the Soviet Union, of coal, wood-pulp, pulp wood, lumber and timber of all kinds, asbestos and furs.
