### NO CANADIAN BISLEY TEAM

TORONTO, January 25—In all probability there will be no Canadian team at Bisley this year. Information has reached Toronto that the Executive of the National Rifle Association of England has decided to recommend the prohibition of the Ross rifle by Canadians.

On the strength of this statement representation is being made to a number of Canadian manufacturers whose assistance is being sought to bring this matter to the attention of the government, at the instance of the manufacturers of this rifle. It is pointed out that the Ross rifle as the general service rifle of the Canadian Militia, is so superior that Canadians have been able to double up on their winnings during the last three years. This has led to dissatisfaction on the part of English shots, who decline to go in with the British service rifle to compete against Canadians, with the result that the entry list is severely threatened and consequently the funds.

Capt. McVittie, a former Bisley man, and enthusiastic rifle shot expressed the opinion of militia men in this statement:—

"We have not heard that the National Association has decided to prohibit the Ross rifle, but if this is so a protest will be made to the Hon. Col. Hughes, Minister of Militia, against Canadians being handicapped by using any other rifles than the general service rifle of the Dominion. Canadians will not submit to that, and the result will likely be that there will be no Bisley team from Canada."

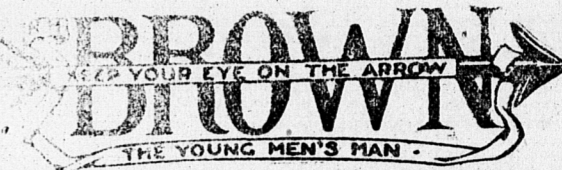
