Another city family has been saddened by the loss of one of its members by drowning, Warren Bush, a boy about 14 years of age, son of Henry Bush, North street, lost his life while bathing at Beatties Beach yesterday afternoon. The circumstances surrounding the accident are not fully known, but young Bush and his younger sister were at the beach for an outing when, it is said, the boy decided to go swimming. The tide was very low and no bathers were around at that time, so he went out to the raft which is used for bathing purposes. There he took off his clothes and waded out towards the scene of operations of the dredges. His little sister says she saw him wade out and when a short distance from the craft he disappeared. The little girl was very much frightened and not realizing what had happened, came at once to her home in North street, on this side of the harbor, where she told her parents of the accident. The little one had not stopped to notify anyone on the west side. Mr. Bush immediately went to the west side and found his son's clothing on the raft. The police were notified and grappling irons procured, but by that time the tide was too high and the body could not be located. The accident occurred between 2 and 3 o'clock, and there was no one near the scene, excepting the little sister, and she was not able to give a very clear account of the accident. Warren Bush was the only son in a family of seven. The family came to the city from Prince Edward Island some time about Christmas, and the father, Henry Bush, has been employed as a longshoreman. At a late hour last night grappling for the body was still going on.—St. John, Ex.

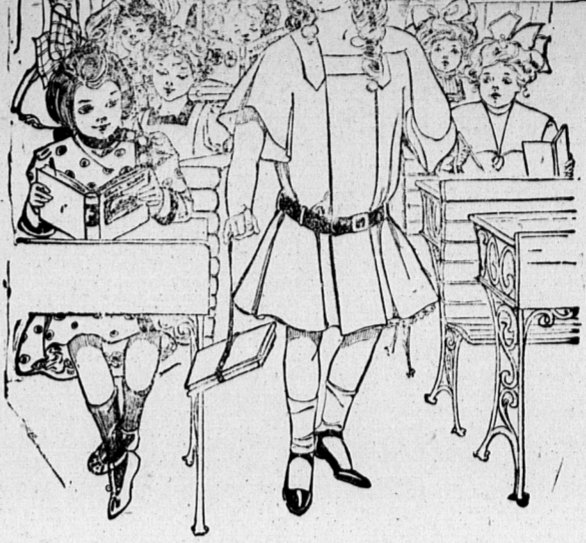
