"PLEASURE CRUISE" To Aid Crippled Children

Medal Is Awarded To Fred E. Horne

(Norwood, Mass. Messenger, Oct. 23) With the plaudits of a packed house ringing in his ears, Fred E. Horne, 16 year old Norwood hero was presented with a medal for bravery by Win Everett, editor of the Norwood Daily Messenger on the stage of the Norwood Theatre last night. Editor Everett represented the American Humane Education Society and presented Horne with the medal on their behalf for his exceptional bravery last summer when during a severe electrical storm, and while half stunned from the shock of a lightning bolt, he entered a burning barn and led to safety four valuable horses and numerous other livestock. Horne's thrilling rescue was made at the Sharon estate of H. P. Kendall on Moose Hill in Sharon at the height of the worst thunder and lightning storm that this section of the country has witnessed in years. The gallant rescue work of

young Horne was noted by the Humane Society and for the first time in the history of Norwood, one of its citizens was chosen to be honored by the society. Mr. Everett, before pinning the medal on the breast of Fred Horne, told the capacity crowd of the youth's exploit and called attention to the fact that it is the first time in the history of the town that a resident has been so honored. As the medal was pinned on his breast on behalf of the Humane Society, by Editor Everett tumultuous applause broke forth from the audience and Freddie was called upon to make a speech. For several minutes, with his face wreathed with smiles, the young hero faced the audience but the words just would not come and he smilingly made his departure with his coveted medal which was well earned by a good night's work last summer. Frederick E. Horne referred to above, whose parents are former Islanders, was born in Norwood, a town of 20,000 about 12 miles west of Boston. Mr. Isahel J. Horne, of Boston, Mr. Isahel E.
