**FROM THE EAST.**  
Good sleighing and fine weather at present with all signs of a mild winter.  
Wilfred and Selden McLean are completing some stylish sleighs which in workmanship and appearance will compare favorably with more pretentious establishments.  
The fishermen here landed some cod fish at Basin Head on the 12th inst, which will probably be the last this year and the latest for a good many ears. As a season is now over it is possible to sum up the results. First, the catch of all kinds of fish was below the average. The spring catch of cod was small; the great body appeared to have sought some other waters. The mackerel fishing which was generally fairly certain here, was a complete and total failure, not a barrel being hooked in these waters. The catch of hake again was short largely owing to the presence of the hated dog-fish. The catch of fall cod-fish has been fair, but during the whole season the fishermen have been handicapped by a scarcity of bait. Herring large and small which during other seasons swarmed all summer and fall in the waters round the shores, and which were used for bait, were here only in small quantities. Probably the presence of the dog fish may account for their absence. The American purse seine can account for the absence of the mackerel as there were none to come, and the Gulf of St. Lawrence, which was their once great summer resort, had no mackerel to cheer the heart of the old time fisherman. Second for the hake and codfish the fishermen secured the best price in their history, in a small measure making up for the shortage in the catch. Third, the fish dryer in Souris under the efficient superintendence of George McFarlane took the fish in every stage, saved the fishermen a large amount of labor and paid prices corresponding to the value in the great consuming centres.  
The cel fishermen are getting fair catches in the Basin and North River. Some shipments have already gone to the American market.  
Frank Warren is kept busy turning out flour for his numerous customers, John Bruce is running his saw mill to the full capacity.
