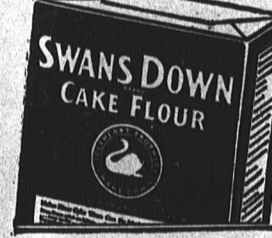

Anglo-French Peace Efforts Are Blocked

PARIS, Feb. 22—(AP)—Spanish Insurgent insurrection on the conditional surrender of Republican Spain threatened tonight to disrupt both plans for ending the civil war and for British and French recognition of General Franco's regime.

Reports reaching the French Government from Burgos said General Franco refused to accept Anastasio hierochuntina (writes a correspondent to the Detroit News) which in a moist atmosphere opens the petals of its corona and in a dry atmosphere closes them.

The Republican Government through President Manuel Azaña, had authorized Great Britain and France to negotiate peace on such a basis.

Senator Leon Bernard was reported to be planning to cross from Spain into France at Hondarribia to seek further instructions from Foreign Minister Georges Bonnet.

Foreign Minister, Count Francisco Gomez Jordana, in Burgos and left immediately for the French frontier where he was believed last night to have made a long report to London by telephone.

The French Cabinet has been summoned to meet Tuesday.

Quebec To Reduce Auto License Fee?

QUEBEC, Feb. 16—(CP)—Quebec Province's revenue from automobile taxation last year increased by \$600,000 over 1937, Provincial Treasurer Martin B. Fiset revealed here today.

The announcement immediately gave rebirth to rumors that the provincial government during the present legislative session might effect reductions in automobile license fees to give Quebec motorists the benefit of the increase.

Most current rumor was that the license fees would be brought down drastically and gasoline taxes would be raised. The reduction in licences from the present rates, possibly higher than in any other province, would leave automobile owners with a good margin of benefit over the increased operating cost the boosted fuel tax would represent. It was in official quarters there was no confirmation of the rumors.

WINNIPEG, Feb. 21—(CP)—Ab Gowankoff of Glenboro, who won the Macdonald's Brier Canadian Curling title for Manitoba last year, lost his chance to repeat today when he lost to Leo Johnson of Winnipeg, 1934 Brier champion, in the British Consols event at the Manitoba bonspiel. The score was 14-10.

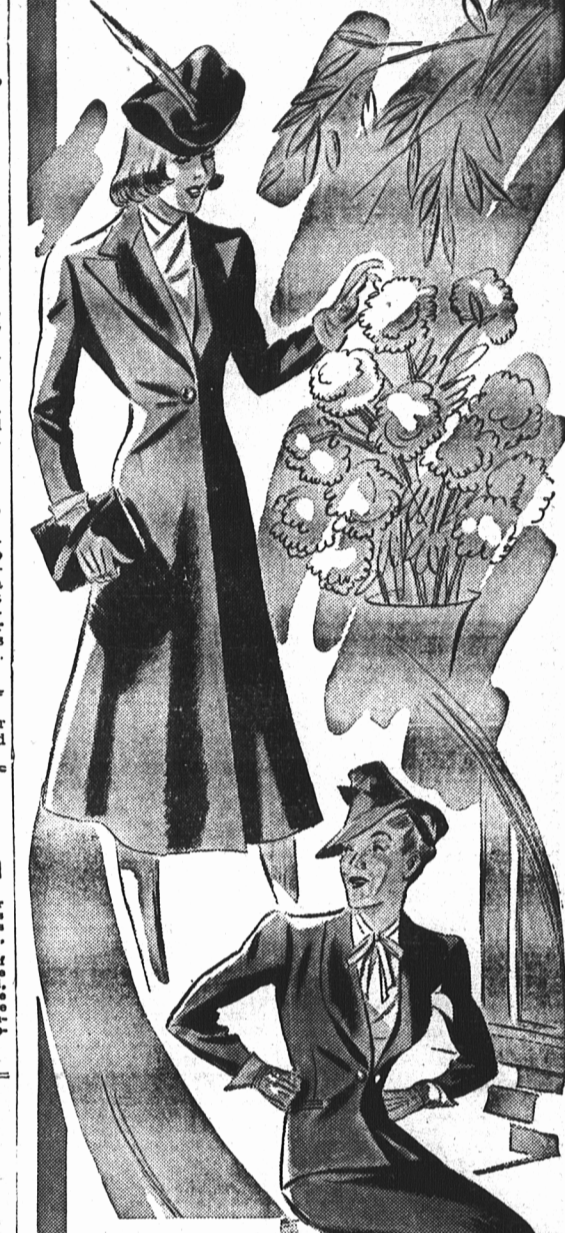
