Notes By The Way

In Quebec, where a bank was threatened with disastrous failure, the provincial Government came to its rescue and no one outside of that province could complain. If the richer Government of Ontario had now come to the rescue of the Home Bank depositors no one outside of Ontario would have objected.

When this matter comes before Parliament, it will be found that the Ontario members especially and without distinction of party will be placed under temptation to vote to reimburse their local constituents at the cost of the Dominion. And with a general election near at hand, how far will they be able to hold a judicial attitude in regard therefore and vote according to the very right of the matter? If, as is expected, the Federal Government shall recommend to Parliament the repayment of the depositors of the Home Bank out of the Dominion treasury and Parliament gives its sanction thereto a fateful departure will be made from which untold evils will result.

Liberal journals which quote as "independent," the political views of the St. John Telegraph Journal, or the Ottawa Citizens are resorting to a stale trick the first fruit of which may be to deceive their own readers. When their readers find out that they have been victimised they will not relish the deception.
