## FRANKFORT BANKER ATTEMPTS SUICIDE

FRANKFORT-ON-THE-MAIN, June 17 (Special)—The failure, on June 11, of the banking firm of Plaut, Hess & Co., of this city, with liabilities of \$287,500 and assets of only \$30,000, caused one of the partners to attempt suicide while another surrendered to the police.

The partners, it is alleged, appropriated securities belonging to their customers in order to cover unsuccessful speculations on the London, Paris and Berlin markets.

## POLICE BESIEGE HOUSE AND SHOOT ASSASSIN

CONSTANTINOPLE, June 14 (Special).—A miniature battle was fought here between a police detachment and a man named Zia, supposed to be one of the assassins of Mahmud Scheket Pacha, with the result that Zia was mortally wounded and a judge and a police officer received bullet wounds.

The detachment of police proceeded early in the morning to a house on Piraeus street, where they had heard Zia was hiding. They surrounded the house and Zia immediately began shooting with a revolver, one of the bullets wounding Lieutenant Hilmi Bey in the chest and another striking the foot of Judge Samuel Effendi, the examining magistrate accompanying the police.

The policemen returned the fire, and shortly afterward entered the house, where they found Zia suffering from a mortal wound.  
The fighting, however was not over, and it was found necessary to call troops to the assistance of the police in capturing the house and pistols were found in the house.

More than one hundred and fifty arrests have been made in connection with the assassination of Mahmud Scheket Pacha.  
Damat Sali Pacha, who is suspected of complicity in the plot because his signature was on a check for a large sum of money which was found in possession of one of the accused men, is the non-in-law of the late Prince Ahmed Kemal-Eddin, a brother of the Sultan.

## TO WELCOME AMERICAN ENGINEERS

BERLIN, June 16.—The German Association of Engineers has completed elaborate arrangements for the reception and entertainment of the members of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers during their approaching visit to Germany. The American visitors are due to arrive at Harburg next Thursday. Two days later they will go to Leipzig to hold their annual meeting. Following the meeting the visitors will make a two-weeks tour of Germany that will embrace many of the principal industrial cities and districts.
