AIR TRANSPORTATION.—In the report of the Air Transportation Committee of the Board of Trade in yesterday's paper two sentences were inadvertently omitted. One referred to the large increase in express matter carried last year by air between Prince Edward Island and Moncton and the other drew attention to the necessity of improvement of the landing facilities at Charlottetown if such planes as are to be used in the Trans-Canada air service are to be enabled to land here.
