**ERNABELLA, South Australia.** Sept. 22 - (CP) - A school for chil- dren of wandering Aborigines is conducted in this little settlement, 400 miles north of Adelaide, by Ernest Trudinger, an Australian fluent in the native dialect. Instruction is given in the Ab- original tongue by Trudinger who teaches writing, arithmetic, draw- ing and singing, elementary car- pentry and gardening. Classes, supported by the state government of South Australia, are held for whatever children happen to be at Ernabella with their nomad parents. Their instruction varies accord- ing to their ages, and on the av- erage there are five classes of five pupils each week. Trudinger, does most of the teaching but some- times leaves classes of smaller children in the care of his older and more apt pupils. He says favorite subjects with the children are drawing and sing- ing. When they sing, they are soon naturally sensitive to pitch, rarely is any one of them out of tune. As a return for his teaching, Trudinger has picked up a fund of information from the children about birds, animals and bush- craft.

**Poultry - Poultry New York Market Rallies At Close**  
(By Victor Eubank)  
**NEW YORK, Sept. 22** - (AP) - The stock market went into another tailspin during the last week - its sixth successive weekly re- lapse - but finished with a good all-round rally. Over the weeks from Aug. 15 quoted values on the stock ex- change suffered a decline of ap- proximately \$15,000,000,000. There were only nine intervening com- backs during the period. In the latest week the market retrieved some \$500,000,000 Monday and above \$1,000,000,000 in Friday's final session. The list rallied, dipped and re- covered in the Friday proceedings. Advances were reduced or cancel- led as dealings slowed. A burst of buying orders again swamped the recording machinery following President Truman's announcement that he had asked for the resig- nation of Secretary Wallace. The pace slackened after midday. On the week The Associated Press 60 stock composite recorded a net loss of 2.4 points at 62.3. Wall Streeters also saw another bearish indicator in the disclosure that manufacturing, wholesale and retail inventories in July touched a record peak of \$30,000,000,000 while the latest federal reserve figures showed that commercial loans of New York city banks jumped \$51,000,000 last week to \$3,370,000,000, a record high. The market stiffened Monday but wiped out its gain Tuesday with activity relatively small in both sessions. The average drop- ped 2 full points Wednesday on r-

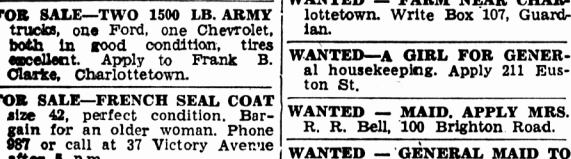
