

NEW YORK, Nov. 5.—The American team of Holmer and Guesel, won the twenty mile international Foot Race in Madison Square Garden, last night in the World's record time of 1 hour 29 minutes and 27 seconds, 4 minutes 23 and 2 seconds better than the record previously made.

The Canadian team of Meadows and Woods was second, and the Swedish team of Ljungstrom and Swenberg, third.
