BASEBALL

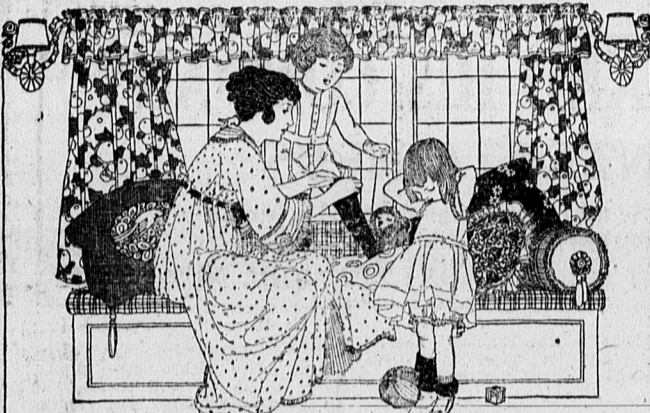

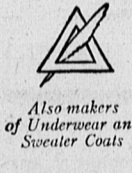
