Twenty-two of the 25 highest corporation salaries paid in the United States in 1938 went to movie stars and executives, the general treasury disclosed today. A \$383,920 salary to Louis B. Mayer, head of Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Corporation, topped them all. The rankings appeared in a treasury list, supplementing an earlier list issued in January, of all corporation salaries in excess of \$75,000. The two lists for 1938 totalled 650 persons. The information is gathered from corporation income tax returns, and made public as required by law. Actress Claudette Colbert topped four of the six business men, and Shirley Temple shaded William S. Knudsen, who in 1938 was president of General Motors, but now is working without salary for the National Defense Commission.

Overseas Shipments

A hint of Great Britain's mastery of the seas is indicated in the recent high level of shipping. The danger of submarines, mines and other hazards, more than 70,000,000 bushels of Canadian wheat have been shipped overseas since Jan. 1, 1939. In the period last year a little more than 52,000,000 bushels were carried to foreign customers.

Overseas Shipments

More than 23,295,000 bushels of wheat were imported from Canada alone last year by Belgium, Luxembourg, Holland, Norway and Denmark. Another victim of Nazi aggression, Poland, usually grows sufficient grain for her own needs.

Overseas Shipments

Biggest buyers of Canadian wheat among the competitive countries were Belgium, which purchased more than 10,451,000 bushels, Holland took 5,932,000, Norway 3,845,000 and Denmark 3,168,000 bushels.

Overseas Shipments

Because of the tight British blockade, these countries now are unable to import wheat from overseas and empty stomachs are expected to increase Hitler's economic woes.

Overseas Shipments

While Canada's export trade may suffer a little because of the lost business, experts say this loss probably will be more than compensated by Argentina's lack of surplus wheat stocks due to a poor winter yield.

Overseas Shipments

It is expected that the southern hemisphere country will be out of the export market for some time because of this shortage and some observers believe that a better than average spring crop will be necessary before Argentina again becomes a factor in overseas trade.

Overseas Shipments

Germany itself purchased almost 7,000,000 bushels of Canadian wheat last year, and must find other sources of supply, while Iceland, Sweden and Finland were sold nearly 2,500,000 bushels of Canadian wheat.
