TOO AMIABLE

The average player is far too willing on defense, to do precisely what a crafty declarer wants him to do.

North dealer Both sides vulnerable North-South 20 on 3-6

Bridge hand table with cards: ♠ K3, ♥ A76, ♦ AK10952, ♣ 82, ♠ QT6, ♥ Q943, ♦ J7, ♣ AJ65, ♠ J8, ♥ K1085, ♦ Q84, ♣ Q1073, ♠ A97542, ♥ 63, ♦ K94

The bidding: North 1♠, East Pass, South 2♠, West 3♠

West's opening lead, a low heart, made matters as difficult as possible for declarer.

West, with a sure trump trick, should have been more discriminating in the use of his trumps! He should have politely declined to over-ruff declarer on the third round of diamonds.

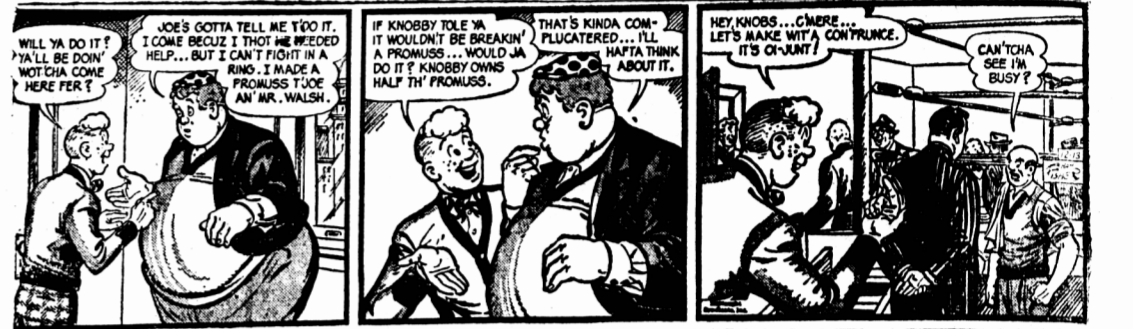

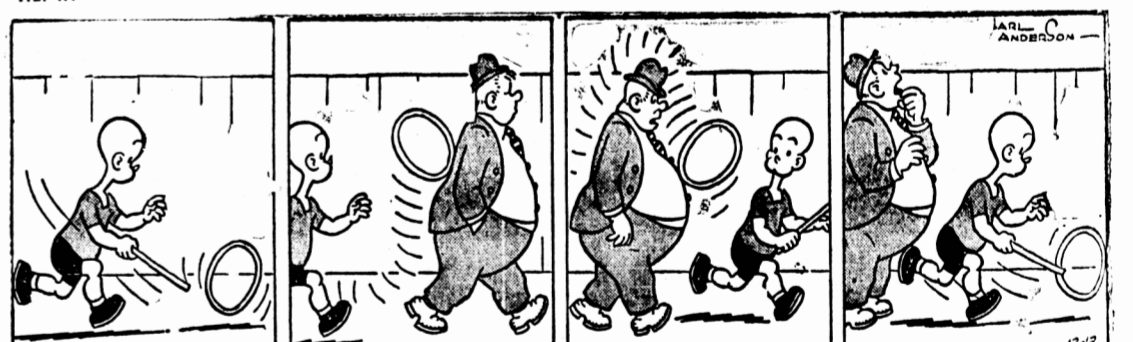
