**JACK FROST HERE.**—The first really severe touch of winter was experienced on Saturday and during Sunday. A strong Northerly breeze added "punch" to the bites of Jack Frost and ears not properly protected by those having occasion to face the blast on Saturday night were liable to get "stung." During Saturday night the official mercury registered a drop of twelve degrees below zero, which was by long odds the "coldest yet" this season. At 9 o'clock Sunday morning it was 6 below. By 3 o'clock in the afternoon the mercury managed to get the upper hand of Jack Frost to the extent of 5 degrees above the zero point, and by 9 o'clock Sunday evening the grip of the weather King was said loosening, the official reading being 6 above. The wind Saturday night had a velocity of 29 miles an hour, and Sunday night at 9 o'clock of 18 miles an hour.
