The Drinking Orchid.

A plant termed by English "Public Opinion" the most extraordinary ever discovered has been brought to light by the exertions of Mr. E. A. Suverkrup of Philadelphia, who during his trip to South America has been for some years contributing to the collection of his friend, Professor N. E. Brown, of the Herbarium, Kew Gardens, London.

Among the orchids I noted one different from the rest, the leaves, sharp lance-head shaped, growing all round the root and radiating from it.

I went over at once to examine my discovery, and was surprised when I touched the plant to see the center stem gradually contract and convulsively roll itself up in a spiral like a roll of tape.

By subsequent observation I found that when the plant was in need of water this tube would gradually unwind till it dipped into the water.

I found many of these plants, all directly over the water, or over the place where he water had been. In the latter case it was almost pitiful to see how the tube would work its way over the ground in search of water that was not there.
