The deceased was then taken ill and died in a very few days. All of this family, with the exception of one son, John, who is in Mexico, were present when he died. He leaves a family of three sons and four daughters and also three brothers and three sisters and a large circle of friends and relatives. His funeral took place to the Hartsville Church on April 5th where a solemn funeral service was conducted by Rev. John Gillis. Although the day was very stormy a very large concourse of people assembled to pay a last tribute of respect to one whom they highly respected. The pall bearers were: D. M. McDonald, J. D. McLeod, Hopevale; Dan McKay of the Dock, Rod'k McLeod, Hartsville, M. A. McKinnon and Rod'k Nicholson, Ross Valley.
