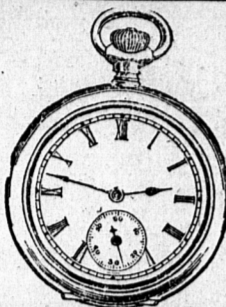

After the presentation supper was served and one of the most pleasant evenings in the history of Fredericton was enjoyed by the host and hostess and the self invited guests. Mr. Weeks is hale and hearty and enjoys the best of health. He has just completed cutting a barn frame one hundred feet long.

The funeral of the late Mrs. Cornelia Lowther Crapaud, was very largely attended, after a short service at the house the remains were taken to the Crapaud Methodist Church where the beautiful and impressive service was conducted by the Rev. W. A. Thompson, pastor of the church. The deceased and her husband who survives until a few years ago when they removed to Rosedale, where Mrs. B. Inman, only sister of the deceased resides, and her demise took place there on Saturday morning. Mrs. Lowther also leaves to mourn four brothers—William and Joseph Story of Crapaud and Thomas and George Story of Tryon. The deceased was in the 77th year of her age. The Winter Time Table on the Prince Edward Island Railway will come into effect on Monday next, January 8th. It will be practically the same as last year. The express train for Tignish will leave Charlottetown every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday at two o'clock, arriving at Tignish at 7.25 p.m. The freight train will leave the other days of the week at noon, arriving at 7.35. A train will leave Tignish at six a.m. daily, arriving here at eleven-thirty a.m. every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday and 1.40 p.m. the other days of the week. A train will arrive from Summerside only at five-fifteen p.m. every day. There will be a train from Cape Traverse every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, arriving here at ten a.m. A train will leave here for Cape Traverse on the same days at 2.55 p.m., arriving at the Cape at five-forty-five. There will only be one train for the East leaving here at three-thirty p.m. daily. The freight train from the East will leave Souris at seven a.m. and Georgetown at six-thirty a.m., arriving in Charlottetown at ten a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. On the other days of the week the train will leave Georgetown and Souris at the same hour, seven a.m., arriving in Charlottetown at ten-fifty-five. The southern train will leave here at three-thirty a.m. on Saturday it will be express, arriving at Murray Harbor at 5.55 p.m. On all other days it will be a mixed train, arriving at Murray Harbor at seven p.m.

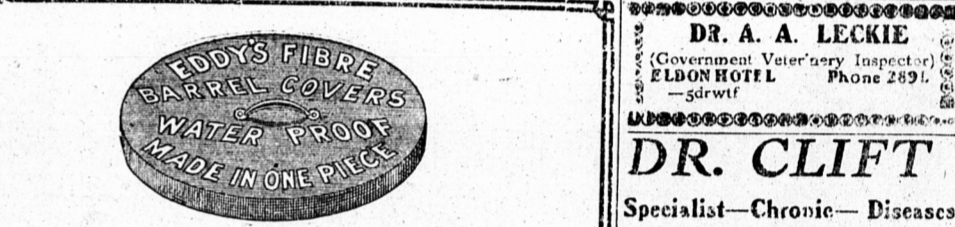
