Mr. W. R. Shaw Comments on Crop outlook

"The hay crop has been above average but poorly saved in most cases," Mr. W. R. Shaw, Deputy Minister of Agriculture stated yesterday in an interview regarding the crop situation on the Island.

Speaking of the grain crop he stated that it could scarcely be up to average. In lowlands overabundance of moisture has retarded growth while in cases where growth has been luxuriant considerable lodging has taken place.

The acreage planted to potatoes has undergone a very drastic reduction from that of the previous year, total decrease amounting to between 5000 and 6000 acres. The average sown to certified seed has been reduced to the extent of about 6000 acres.
