PRODUCES GOOD PULP FROM SUGAR CANE
WINSTED, Conn., Jan. 11—Paper pulp has been produced from sugar cane at the mill of a local company according to the foreman in charge there.
Dr. J. H. Bute, of Houston, Texas, crossed the mill about the middle of December for experiments in making paper pulp from sugar cane.
Information as to the process employed in making pulp is given on the pulp could be beaten to a very fine state and be made into a good grade of paper.
Experiments by the score have been made with the sugar cane and corn stalks before, but had never been entirely successful.
Dr. Bute has returned to Texas highly elated over the results of the tests of his secret process.
