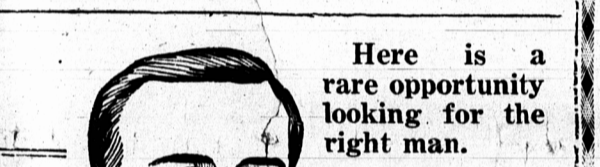

"A combination of money and sentiment," one doctor gave as the principal reason why the students were anxious to give their blood to patients in need of it.
