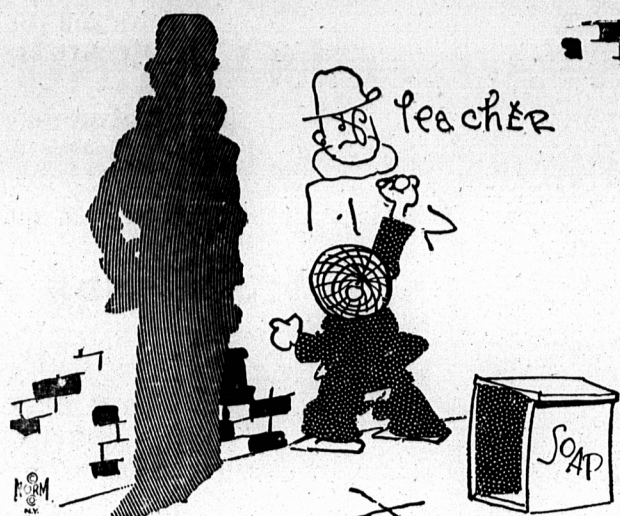

NEW YORK, Sept. 1—(AP)—Foreign exchange dealings were practically becalmed today although Sterling once more gave ground in terms of the United States dollar.  
Sterling dipped 1-2 cent to \$4-85-3/8 and the French franc 00 1-8 of a cent to 2.72 1-4. The guilders was .03 of a cent lower, the Swiss franc down .01 of a cent and the belga 00 1-2 of a cent. The Canadian dollar was up 1-32 of a cent at 99 7-8.

Finance

OTTAWA, Sept. 1—(CP)—Dominion Government deposits with the bank of Canada totalled \$12,793,000 a decrease of \$1,546,000 from the previous week ended Aug. 21. Chartered bank deposits declined to \$202,250,000 from \$202,374,000 in the previous week. The ratio of net reserve to notes and deposit liabilities was 55.14 per cent, compared with 55.23 a week ago.

MONTREAL, Sept. 1—(CP)—Open produce market traders bid medium grade eggs up another 1-4 to 1-2 cent today according to Dominion Department of Agriculture reports. Western butter prices improved slightly while others remained unchanged.  
Creamery butter prints to retail dealers sold for 24 3-4-25 cents and solids for 24 1-4-25. Western butter delivered here was offered at 24 cents. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized butter wholesale jobbing was 23 5-8 cents.  
Cheese sold at 14 1-8-1-4 cents a pound for Ontario colored, 14 for Quebec white and 14 1-8 for Quebec colored.  
Graded egg shipments in used free cases sold at 33 1-2-34 cents a dozen for A-large, 32 for A-medium, 24 1-2-25 for B and 20 1-2-21 for C.  
Potatoes, Quebec No. 1 80's 55-60, Quebec No. 2 80's 30-40-45.
