## Smart Frocks for Spring Wear. By Dorothy Dale.

Although winter is still with us, designs for spring gowns are shown among all the models.

It is a little early to speak about the best suits—that is, the skirt and coat gowns, although a great many of the spring tailors are already showing the new cloths and designs. Among the suits for coat and skirt costumes, grays or all checks and plaids in black and white promise to be extremely fashionable. Fine stripes and cloths woven to give the effect of a stripe, will also be much in vogue, the styles of the more severely tailored frocks being much on the order of those worn during the winter. The semi-fitted hip-length coat, with plain notched revers collar in mannish

fashion, worn with a side-plaited or box-plaited skirt, will be very fashionable, although the Eton models in cloths will also be seen on many well-gowned women. Gored skirts are also seen on a few of the new models in light-weight cloth, a great many goreds being used, so that the skirt, while fitting very snugly about the upper part, is very flaring about the lower.

One very smart suit recently turned out by a New York tailor was of black and brown check material, the very narrow front gore of the skirt being cut on the bias of the material, while the rest of the gores were cut on the straight.

The coat was made single-breasted in semi-fitted hip length, and had collar and cuffs of tan broadcloth. Street dresses of pincee, rajah or taffe a silk, velvety or

light-weight cloth will be much worn this spring to take the place of the coat and skirt costume.

One of these gowns sketched had the bodice made with a rounded detachable guipure made of hand-embroidered mull and trimmed with lace insertion. The model gown was in blue and black check voile, made over dark blue silk.

The other costume illustrated would be suitable for silk or any light-weight cloth or velvet. The skirts had a plaited section set on about the lower part.

The yoke of the bodice was of embroidery batiste, with points of Irish lace insertion about the top of the collar. Three rather deep tucks were laid in the material across the front and back of the corsage at the lower part.

## Savory Meat and Fish Sauces. By Sara Cranford

**White Sauce.**—For this sauce beat together two tablespoonfuls of butter, two tablespoonfuls of flour, one cupful of milk or white stock and one-fourth a teaspoonful each of salt and pepper.

**Allemande Sauce.**—Add to a pint of white sauce one-fourth cupful of mushroom liquor, reduced by simmering to about one tablespoonful, also some mushrooms cut in halves and the yolks of two eggs beaten and mixed with one tablespoonful of creamed butter. Before adding the yolks and butter remove the saucepan from the fire, let cool a minute or two, then add a little of the sauce to the egg; mix thoroughly, add more sauce, mix and return to the saucepan and stir over the fire for a few minutes without boiling.

**Cheese Sauce.**—Let half a cupful of

bachel sauce, three-fourths of a cupful of cream, a dish of paprika and one-quarter of a pound of cheese, cut into thin shavings, stand over hot water until the cheese is melted; stir until smooth and serve at once. This sauce is to be used with baked or boiled fish, chicken, boiled cauliflower, rice with or without oysters, or, with some of the cream omitted, as a filling for cheese patties.

**Sauce for Boiled Fish.**—Make the usual veloute sauce, using the water in which the fish was cooked; cook a bay-leaf, a slice of onion and part of a carrot with the fish, or fry the vegetables in the butter used for the roux. The ordinary veloute sauce made with veal or chicken stock may also be used with

the fish. For egg sauce add two half-boiled eggs cut into slices.

**Tomato Sauce.**—Cook a can of tomatoes, half an onion with a clove in it, a stalk of celery, a sprig of parsley, a bay leaf and half a teaspoonful of salt for 20 minutes, then strain and cool. For each cupful of puree, make a white roux with two tablespoonfuls each of butter and flour; then when cool add the puree and half a teaspoonful of meat extract; or use part stock and part puree. The sauce should be quite thick.

**Brown Sauce.**—This sauce is made the same as white sauce, with the stock brown instead of white. Prepare a brown roux, being careful not to burn it, and add the sauce to it.

## Suggestions for Guest Luncheons

A luncheon is one of the most popular and agreeable forms of entertaining. Like dinners, luncheons are of many sorts, from the most informal with from four to six at table, to large, more formal affairs, where covers are laid for from twelve to forty or fifty people. Such large entertainments are too costly and

elaborate for the average housekeeper to attempt.

The invitations for luncheon are the same in form as those for dinner. The women guests wear street costumes or afternoon gowns. They lay off their wraps but do not remove their hats.

The seating of the guests is usually arranged by having cards designating the place at table to be occupied by that guest. The women guests all enter the dining-room in advance of the hostess. If the luncheon is given for a visitor, or for a stranger whom the guests are especially invited to meet, she is given the seat of honor.

After the luncheon is over, the hostess should see that the guests are properly served with coffee and dessert. For this course serve ice-cream or jelly or some fancy dessert with whipped cream.
