Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions. Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions. A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$10.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300. The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions. W. W. QUAY, C. M. G. GUNNER McVARISH MAKES SUPRIME SACRIFICE

Mr. Frank McVarish, Souris Line Rtd., has received the following letters, one from Rev. W. J. Gallagher, Irish Kings, Liverpool Regiment, B. E. F., and from H. W. Peake, Lieut 8th Siege Battery relative to the death of his son John who was killed in action July 17th. Gunner McVarish who was only nineteen years of age enlisted in the 8th Siege Battery in May 1916 and made many friends for himself.

2-8 Irish K. L. R., B. E. F.

Dear Mr. Varish,—

I expect you have by this time learned of the death of your son John P. McVarish (R. I. P.) He was killed beside his gun at 6.30 p. m. July 17th. He had been very regularly to confession and Holy Communion. I am not quite certain whether he was there the evening before he was killed but I know he was there very shortly before. In any case he was a very good boy for I used to see him very often down at our little church. Catholics out here have a great consolation when they are prepared they have the hope of eternal life. The only grief is for their relatives who will miss them. Your son was very highly thought of by all his comrades. They are very sorry to lose him. I know myself that he was one of the best boys one could meet. I have applied for a photograph of the grave to be sent to you. He is buried in perhaps the best kept cemetery in France.

I was with your son a few minutes after he was hit and conditionally anointed him. With very sincere sympathy, From sincerely yours, W. J. G. GALLAGHER, C.F. France, July 19, 1917.

Dear Mrs. McVarish,—

I feel I must write you a few lines of sympathy in the great loss you have been called upon to bear. Jack's life in the battery was so clean and upright, and he was always a most prompt and willing worker. If you could only hear the way he is spoken of by his comrades, I know it would bring a ray of comfort into your hours of sadness. It must be comforting to know that he suffered no pain and although his death was instantaneous I believe Jack was well prepared, for late his chums have often noticed the keen attention he has paid to his religious duties.

In a very well kept cemetery near here there are now five graves side by side. One is your son's. They are graves of five of our very best men, men who will long be remembered by every member of this unit. It was the one shell that caused each death and I can assure you it has cast a gloom of intense sorrow throughout the battery.

SOLDIER CALLS FOR A STRONG RESERVE

"Tell Enemy We Mean to Go On," Writes Pte. Frederick Webber.

The following letter, written by Pte. Frederick Webber from "Somewhere in France," to a prominent citizen, indicates the feeling of the men in the trenches regarding the need for reinforcements at the front. The letter reads in part, "I have just received some papers from home and have been reading Sir Wilfrid Laurier's speech against conscription on June 18. I notice he says there never was since the war began any danger of invasion by Germany.

Where Protection Lies.

"Who is responsible for this security?" he asks. "Is it the Rainbow or Niobe? No. Look across the stormy Atlantic and North Seas and see those silent grey ships in all weather, night and day, month after month, year after year. Those faithful sailors, God bless them. The British navy is my humble opinion, is one of the most surest safeguards against invasion and if Canada had those super-dreadnoughts along the coast which were voted down some years ago it would be more effective than all the talking in the world. Every school boy should know that Germany has every river, creek etc., known. Is there no other landing for troops, but under the guns of Halifax or Quebec? And only for the British navy, Sir Wilfrid would soon find that invasion was possible. Then there would be a rush to arms I expect, but, too late. Wait till the enemy is at our homes? Never!"

First Line of Defence.

I firmly believe with Sir George Foster that our first line of defence is right here in France and Belgium. I believe that the future of generations yet unborn will be decided here, the future of our vast Dominion. I pray that God will give our statement wisdom through this crisis; let envy be hushed, away with politics, let all sects and creeds be united and the people stand together as a nation. We are in honor bound to see this terrible war end in a successful way for our Empire.

What of the hundreds of thousands who left their grief-stricken wives and children to go out into the unknown? Why did these men tear themselves from all they hold dear on this earth? Thirty-one years ago I swore to love, cherish and protect my wife. I am doing that in France today, that our families shall Canada's Waterloo, Vlamy Ridge? Will

be immune from the brutal insults of the barbarians of Europe, that our aged parents shall remain in their quiet peaceful homes, that our children should remain as God made them. These, Sir, are a few of the reasons why our men left homes of comfort for the trenches.

Appeal to Young Men.

"Look at the map and see the heritage our forefathers left for us; look at our men in France today who are making history; did they wait for conscription? We want your help now. Even if you never fire a shot or handle a tool, a strong reserve tells the enemy we mean to go on. Young men, what do you think of St. Julien Ypres, Festubert, Courcellette and you come and make history? Come and hear the boys singing as they march through the still hours of the night to the front line; come and hear the ringing cheer as "over the top" they go. You will feel a better man I am sure.

I would that the people of Canada could see this once fair land of France, which has been watered with the tears and blood of millions of its defenders, the once prosperous communes now all desolation and ruin, one vast graveyard, its beautiful trees all cut down, its fields weeds, its orchards destroyed, the image of our Saviour riddled with shrapnel but we pass on and this pestilence is still in our midst. I appeal to the young men of Canada. Come over in your thousands and help stem this mighty power. Don't wait for conscription, get into harness right now."

RUSSIAN IDLERS TO BE REMOVED

PETROGRAD.—A partial evacuation of Petrograd by idle and non-productive elements of the population to alleviate the economic crisis, which daily is becoming more acute, was favorably considered by the government at the conference yesterday and the question referred to the Minister of Justice for his approval.

Such a measure is absolutely necessary to ameliorate the food shortage, according to the conclusion reached by the government. The order of evacuation, if promulgated—and it is likely that it will be—will provide for the transfer of all institutions and individuals not productively engaged in Petrograd or necessary to the economic or official life of the city.

The measure will aim to remove from the capital the burden of the idle parasitic population, which foments disorders and which to a great extent was responsible for the recent uprisings. Schools probably will be included among the institutions transferred from the city.

A special permit designating the business of the bearer will be required of persons entering the city.

The Provisional Government has postponed until August 23-24 the meeting of the extraordinary national council of Moscow. Members of all Dumas, representatives of the municipalities, zemstvos, councils of workmen and soldiers' delegates and other political and social organizations will participate in the conference, which was called by Premier Kerensky late last month.

The government will make at the conference a declaration concerning the serious conditions in the country, emphasize the necessity of great sacrifices from all classes and announce measures which it proposes to take.

Although no official announcement had been made, it virtually has been decided to postpone the convocation of the constituent assembly, owing to the unpreparedness of the population for an election campaign and the impossibility of finishing in time
