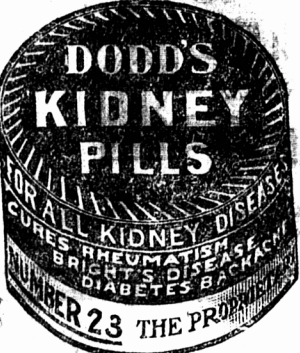

LAUNDRY WAYS.

Some of the prettiest lingerie waists are so simple this season that laundering them at home is by no means a difficult matter, and if one only has the time to spare for it there will surely be a saving of money, as laundry bills have an unpleasant habit of mounting up.

To wash, lay the blouse in warm water made sudsy with good white soap and a little borax. If the waist is much soiled let it stay in the water overnight. Next morning squeeze it out and wash in warm suds, lifting the waist up and down in the water, but never rubbing it. Soap should never be rubbed on fine material because doing so thickens the threads and makes the material look coarse.

Then clean rinse in warm water then in cold. If the blouse looks yellow use a few drops (a very few) of liquid bluing. Starch should be used only in the smallest quantity. Mix a table-spoonful of raw starch in a little cold water and pour on boiling water until it becomes the consistency of cream. Pass the blouse through this and squeeze.

Next lay on a clean towel and roll up. Leave for some hours and then take out the waist. Shake it well, and if still wet hang up until only damp. Have good hot irons and see that they are perfectly clean. Use good mat and if necessary emery paper. Any bits of black on the irons will surely be transferred to the blouse, as most amateur laundress knows.

Embroidery and laces are ironed on the wrong side. To iron the blouse first do the collar and cuffs, next the sleeves. The backs come next in order and the fronts last. All colored materials will have a better finish, if ironed on the wrong

side of the fabric.

If the material is washed for the first time it should be laid in salt and water or vinegar and water for twenty minutes. The former is used for pink and blue shades and the latter of green and mauve.

The proportions are a handful of salt or a half teacupful of vinegar to a gallon of cold water. Thin flannel blouses require the utmost care in washing.

They should never be allowed to soak over five minutes and soap should never be used directly upon them. Neither must the water be too hot. All these cause shrinkage but the greatest damage is done by rubbing soap on the flannel.

MUSIC IN THE BIBLE.

An interesting article on musical subjects of various kinds, as depicted by modern artists, forms the fine art feature of the September "Windsor Magazine." Some sixteen important pictures are reproduced in more or less chronological order, beginning with such ancient themes as "Orpheus with his Lute," "The Boy David playing before Saul," and ranging down through such mediæval themes as "Frank Dic'see's famous 'Harmony' to Shakespearean subjects by Rossetti and Edwin Abbey and then to such modern pictures as Wolf's "Bethoven," Opf'lar's "The Moonlight Sonata," and Stanhope's "Orpheus 'Andante Espresso.'" The late Edwin Abbey's picture, "Oh, Mistress Mine, Where are you Roaming?" from the song in "Twelfth Night," forms the coloured plate.

In the course of the article the writer says in distinguishing between instrumental and vocal themes:— "Some of the earliest in chronological order of any such further themes belong jointly to both groups, and are necessarily mentioned in the present article. The triumphal song of Miriam, for instance, described in Exodus XVI, in which her brother, the great law-giver, Moses, and the Israelites celebrated their successful

passing over the Red Sea, cannot be considered only as a vocal expression of joy, for we are told that she "took a timbrel in her hand, and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances."

Similarly, although David "being dead, yet speaketh" to use in the great spiritual literature which we know as the Psalms, it was not primarily as singer, but as a skilled player upon sundry instruments that he first charmed the distraught mind of King Saul, and later, although he "sang praises," it was "with a psaltery and an instrument with ten strings."

William Gale's picture of "The Song of Miriam" is, therefore, an illustration rather of the visual choros dance of the Israelites, and the paintings by Joseph Israels, Ernest Norman and other artists of "The Boy David Singing before Saul" deal rather with his instrumental talents than with his lyrical gift.

"We know that Saul said unto his servants: 'Provide me now a man that can play well and bring him to me,' and that, in response, when David, the son of Jesse, was brought before him, and 'took the harp and played with his hand, Saul was refreshed. And, again, we know that 'David and all the house of Israel played before the Lord on all manner of instruments made of firwood, even on harps, and on psalteries (a kind of harp), and on timbrels, (a drum or tabor), and on cornets, and on cymbals; and that 'Jeduthun 'prophesied with a harp.'"
