THE RENAISSANCE

But after that space of a thousand years, it seemed as though again God had said, "Let there be light, and there was light." Through the blackness of passing years at length appeared the breaking of a new brilliancy, while in quickly increasing waves the Renaissance, from its insignificant beginnings in Italy swept gradually with ever accelerated pace over Europe, and medievalism was doomed.
