**The Rise Of Canada**

(Continued from Page 4)

prosperity in Canada. One believes that the next quarter of a century will witness the greatest expansion in settlement and production not only in the life of the Dominion but in the history of the Continent. It must be remembered, too, that for the most part the United States has had its amazing development through the exploitation of just such resources as Canada possesses in such abundant measure. We have a pulp and paper industry which exports to an annual value of \$150,000,000. We have now an annual production of gold in excess of \$30,000,000, and in Porcupine and Ronny two of the greatest gold fields ever discovered. There is abundance of coal in Nova Scotia, Alberta and British Columbia and an increasing national determination to supply the Canadian market from the mines of the coal-producing Provinces. More and more we are giving attention to scientific and industrial research and to all practical measures to discover and develop the natural resources of the Dominion. Dr. A. P. Coleman of the University of Toronto, a sober and responsible authority, has said: "The last twenty-five years have seen the discovery of the Yukon laces, the Cobalt Silver region and the Porcupine gold and the operation of the Creighton nickel mine, much the greatest in the world, and the opening up of the great coal fields of Alberta. It is natural to expect that the next quarter of a century, with a rapidly growing population, and so wide a stretch of virgin territory, will see equally important discoveries and there is no evident reason why Canada should not in time rival its great neighbor, the United States, as a mining country." Of the rain-producing capacity of Canada all the world knows. For this year the total wheat yield is estimated at 422,000,000 bushels of a total value of \$600,000,000 or \$700,000,000. And there are many millions of virgin acres in the West still to come under the plow and oom for a great increase in the farming population of all the older provinces. This is the immediate situation in Canada and this the confident outlook of the Canadian people although they are hindered by professional pessimists and now and again discouraged by failure to realize too sanguine expectations. Nor were Canadians ever more anxious to be good neighbors to the United States, to interpret the British Empire to the American people in terms of amity and good will and to share in the blessing which falls upon the peacemakers among mankind. If it be true, as it is, that Canadians, of whom you are far too many, become good and loyal citizens of this Republic, it is just as true that Americans who come to Canada constitute one of the best elements of our population industrious, enterprising, well-living and well-doing and loyal to the institutions under which they live. "Partners in Peace" was the title of a little book I published a year or so ago, interpreting as best I could the relations which exist and ought to exist between the United States, Great Britain and Canada, and partners in peace one believes we will remain through the generations.

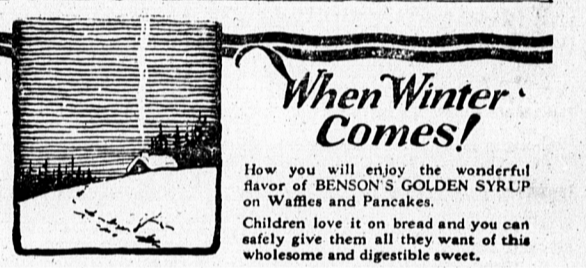
