LONDON, July 3. — Viscount Byng, of Vimy, former Governor-General of Canada and leader of the Canadian Corps at Vimy Ridge, will succeed Sir William Horwood as commissioner of the metropolitan police and head of Scotland Yard, it was announced in the House of Commons today.
